1. The first set of the Ten Commandments

- a) Made of Stone
- b) 40 days and 40 nights
- c) Exodus 19-20; 32-34

2. The second set of the Ten Commandments

- a) Made of acacia wood
- b) Deposited in the Ark of the Covenant
- c) Deuteronomy 10

THE TRIBE OF LEVI

1. Death of Aaron

2. Eleazar anointed as the next high priest

3. The Levites set aside to serve the Lord

- a) To bear the Ark
- b) To stand before the Lord
- c) To bless the name of the Lord (Deuteronomy 10:8)

4. The portion of the Levites

- a) Not physical land
- b) But the LORD God Himself (Deuteronomy 10:9)
