1. With age

2. With success / wealth

3. Indulgence in drinking

4. Drunkenness of Noah

- a) He became uncovered in his tent            Genesis 9:21
- b) This was an undignified event

**TWO DIFFERENT RESPONSES**

1. Ham, the father of Canaan            Genesis 9:22

- a) He saw the nakedness of Noah
- b) He spoke about this to Shem and Japheth
- c) He did not cover his father

2. Shem and Japheth  
Genesis 12:23

- a) They took a garment
- b) Laid in on their shoulders
- c) Walked backward and covered their father's nakedness
- d) Their faces were turned away and they did not see Noah's nakedness

1. He woke up from his drunkenness                      Genesis 9:24
2. He learned about Ham's behavior                      Genesis 9:24
3. Two pronouncements
  - a) Cursing of Canaan
    - i)        This is a reference to the offspring of Ham                      Genesis 9:25
    - ii)       He will be servant to his brethren
  - b) Blessing of Shem and Japheth
    - i)        Blessing the LORD
    - ii)       Canaan would be the servant
    - iii)     The tents of Shem and Japheth be enlarged                      Genesis 9:26-27
