

Romans 14:5-6**UNDERSTANDING THOSE WHO MAY HAVE DIFFERENT OPINIONS ABOUT “DAYS”**

1. One person esteems one day above another Romans 14:5a
 - a) Holy days
 - b) Seasons (Christmas/ Easter)
 - c) Different opinions have divided Christendom
 - i) Eastern Orthodoxy
 - ii) Roman Catholicism
 - iii) Protestantism
2. Another esteems every day alike Romans 14:5b
 - a) Some will observe all days alike
 - b) No special days
 - i) All days special
 - ii) All days ordinary
3. Let each be fully convinced in his own mind Romans 14:5c
 - a) Takes much maturity to come to this understanding
 - b) Much magnanimity too
4. Opposites: With reference to “Days”
 - a) He who observes the day observes it to the Lord Romans 14:6a
 - b) He who does not observe the day, to the Lord he does not observe it Romans 14:6b
5. Opposites: With reference to “Food”
 - a) He who eats, eats to the Lord, for he gives God thanks Romans 14:6c
 - b) And he who does not eat, to the Lord he does not eat, and gives God thanks Romans 14:6d
