3. He sent greetings too Romans 16:22

1. Gaius, my host Romans 16:23a
2. The whole church of Gaius Romans 16:23b
3. Erastus, the treasurer of the city Romans 16:24a
 - a) He was mentioned in Acts 19:22
 - b) And also in 2 Timothy 4:20
 - c) He must have held a prominent public ministry as "treasurer"
4. Quartus Romans 16:24b
