- 1. Instruction of the Disciples
 - a) This was captured in Matthew 10
 - b) This was noted as "Commanding His twelve disciples"
- 2. The ministry of the Lord Jesus
 - a) To teach
 - b) To preach the gospel
 - c) In the cities
- 3. A query from John the Baptiser
 - a) John was imprisoned by Herod Antipas
 - b) He still had faithful disciples
 - c) He sent 2 of his disciples to raise this question to the Lord Jesus

"Are You the Coming One, or do we look for another?" Matthew 11:3

4. Why was this question raised up?

¹Now it came to pass, when Jesus finished commanding His twelve disciples, that He departed from there to teach and to preach in their cities.

² And when John had heard in prison about the works of Christ, he sent two of his disciples

³ and said to Him, "Are You the Coming One, or do we look for another?"

⁴ Jesus answered and said to them, "Go and tell John the things which you hear and see:

⁵ The blind see and the lame walk; the lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear; the dead are raised up and the poor have the gospel preached to them.

⁶ And blessed is he who is not offended because of Me."

- a) John was languishing in prison
- b) He had proclaimed the Lord Jesus as the Lamb of God
- c) He knew the Lord Jesus as the Son of God
- d) But being in prison:
 - i) Doubts arose
 - ii) Faith was shaken somewhat
- 5. John the Baptiser and his ministry

 - a) To stay "blessed"
 - b) To not become "stumbled" because of the Lord Jesus

- c) The sign-miracles must help John to continue:
 - i) To trust
 - ii) To fight doubts
 - iii) To avoid being stumbled ("offended")
