- a) That you may live
- b) And multiply
- c) And go in and possess the land (Deuteronomy 8:1)

3. Taking care to remember

- a) That the LORD your God led you (Deuteronomy 8:2)
- b) Forty years (Deuteronomy 8:2)
- c) To humble you
- d) And test you
- e) To know what is in your heart (Deuteronomy 8:2)
 - i) To obey
 - ii) Or not

4. The humbling work

- a) He allowed you to hunger (Deuteronomy 8:3)
- b) And fed you with manna
Which you did not know
Nor did your fathers know (Deuteronomy 8:3)

5. The Vital Lesson

- a) That He might make you know
- b) That man shall not live by bread alone
- c) But man lives by every word
That proceeds from the mouth of the LORD (Deuteronomy 8:3)

6. God's provision

- a) Your garments did not wear out on you (Deuteronomy 8:4)
- b) Nor did your feet swell these forty years (Deuteronomy 8:4)

7. The chastening of the LORD

- a) As a man chastens his son
- b) So the LORD chastens you (Deuteronomy 8:5)
- c) You shall know this in your heart (Deuteronomy 8:5)
