IMPROPER WORSHIP

1. Present worship practices to cease

a) You shall not at all do as we are doing today (Deuteronomy 12:8)

b) Everyman doing whatever is right in his own eyes (Deuteronomy 12:8)

b) Only in the prescribed chosen place (Deuteronomy 12:14)

c) This is an express commandment of God (Deuteronomy 12:14)

 d) To remember the Levite who serves in their midst; he has no portion nor inheritance in the Land
