- 1. Who were the Amalekites?
 - a) They came from the line of Esau
 - b) Grandson of Esau was called Amalek (Genesis 36:16)
- 2. The Amalekites
 - a) Nomads
 - b) Marauders
- 3. They attacked Israel without provocation

INTRODUCTION TO JOSHUA

- 1. Assigned to lead an army to defend Israel (Exodus 17:8)
- 2. He was entrusted to form an army

MOSES' ROLE

- 1. He will pray for Israel
- 2. He will make use of the rod which had now become a symbolic instrument
- 3. Two supporters with Moses
 - a) Aaron
 - b) Hur
- 4. Holding up of hands in prayer (Exodus 17:11)
 - a) Holding up hands

Israel prevailed

b) Letting down hand

Amalek prevailed

c) Tired hands upheld by Aaron and Hur (Exodus 17:12)

5. Joshua defeats Amalek

(Exodus 17:13)

PRONOUNCEMENT OF JUDGMENT AGAINST AMALEK

1. A divine judgment

(Exodus 17:14)

- a) The name of Amalek would be blotted out
- b) This tribe would be punished
- 2. This judgment would be written down in a book

ALTAR RAISED

1. Altar called "The-LORD-is-my Banner"

(Exodus 17:15)

- 2. The Lord would wage war against the Amalekites from generation to generation
- 3. This was a divine oath from the Lord

(Exodus 17:16)
