## 恶园户的比喻

1. “你们再听一个比喻” 《马太福音 21：33》
  - a. 恶园户的比喻
  - b. 在两个儿子的比喻后续教
  - c. 针对祭司和民间的长老
2. 有个家主 《马太福音 21：33-34》
  - a. 栽了一个葡萄园，周围圈上篱笆
  - b. 里面挖了一个压酒池，盖了一座楼
  - c. 租给园户，就往外国去了
  - d. 收果子的时候近了
    - i. 家主就打发仆人到园户那里
    - ii. 去收果子

iii. 这是园户向家主支付的租金

## 园户邪恶的反应

1. 打发的第一组仆人 《马太福音 21: 35》
  - a. 园户拿住仆人
  - b. 打了一个，杀了一个，用石头打死一个
2. 打发的第二组仆人 《马太福音 21: 36》
  - a. 比先前那组更多人
  - b. 但是园户还是照样待他们
3. 打发家主的儿子 《马太福音 21: 37》
  - a. 希望园户会尊敬他的儿子
  - b. 不料，园户却杀了儿子，占他的产业
4. 家主的明显反应 《马太福音 21: 40-41》
  - a. 他会下毒手除灭那些邪恶的园户
  - b. 他会将葡萄园另租给那按时交果子的园户

## 从恶园户的比喻学习重要的教训

1. 祭司长和文士的邪恶被凸显
  - a. 从语境中指出祭司长和文士
    - i. 他们是宗教领袖（园户）
    - ii. 受上帝的托付（家主）

iii. 照顾以色列（葡萄园） 《以赛亚书 5》

b. 他们不断作恶

i. 对待上帝的先知和使者（家主的仆人）

ii. 对待人子（家主的儿子）

c. 审判将来临

i. 因为他们没有停止作恶

ii. 上帝会因他们的罪严厉审判他们

2. 给大家实际的应用

a. 对待上帝所交托的事务要负责任

b. 要对上帝有交代

c. 对人子及祂的仆人给予应得的尊敬及荣耀

d. 上帝呼召我们做的事都必须结果子

## **INTRODUCTION**

1. Continuing our Pulpit Series – “Deeper lessons from the ministry of the Lord”

a. To study the continuing ministry of the Lord Jesus

b. To learn deeper lessons as His disciples

2. Our focus today – “The Parable of the Wicked Vinedressers”

Matthew 21:33-41

## **THE PARABLE OF THE WICKED VINEDRESSERS**

1. "Hear another parable"      Matthew 21:33
  - a. The Parable of the Wicked Vinedressers
  - b. Taught in succession to the Parable the Two Sons
  - c. Directed to the chief priests and elders
  
2. A certain landowner      Matthew 21:33-34
  - a. Planted a vineyard and set a hedge around it
  - b. Dug a winepress in it and built a tower
  - c. Leased it to vinedressers and went afar
  - d. When vintage-time drew near
    - i. The landowner sent his servants to the vinedressers
    - ii. To receive some fruit
    - iii. This was meant as the vinedressers' payment to him for the lease

## **THE WICKED RESPONSE OF THE VINEDRESSERS**

1. The first set of servants that was sent      Matthew 21:35
  - a. The vinedressers took them
  - b. Beat one, killed one, stoned another
  
2. The second set of servants that was sent      Matthew 21:36
  - a. More servants than the first group
  - b. Yet they were treated likewise by the vinedressers
  
3. The son of the landowner sent      Matthew 21:37
  - a. In hope that the vinedressers will respect the son
  - b. Instead, the vinedressers killed the son to seize his inheritance

4. The obvious response from the landowner Matthew 21:40-41
  - a. He will destroy the wicked vinedressers when he comes
  - b. He will lease his vineyard to good vinedressers who would render to him the fruits in their seasons

### **IMPORTANT LESSONS FROM THE PARABLE OF THE WICKED VINEDRESSERS**

1. The wickedness of the chief priests and scribes highlighted
  - a. A reference to the chief priests and scribes contextually
    - i. They were religious leaders (vinedressers)
    - ii. Who had been entrusted by God (landowner)
    - iii. To look after Israel (vineyard) cf. Isaiah 5
  - b. Their repeated wickedness
    - i. Towards God's prophets and messengers (landowner's servants)
    - ii. Towards the Son of God (landowner's son)
  - c. The judgement to come
    - i. Because they never relented from wickedness
    - ii. God would severely judge them for their sins
2. Practical application for everyone
  - a. Being responsible in what God has entrusted to us
  - b. Being accountable to God
  - c. Giving due honor and regard to His Son and His servants
  - d. Being fruitful in all that God has called us to do
