关于世界末期的深奥教训

1. 主耶稣对殿宇的预言
 - a. 殿宇将要被拆毁 《马太福音 24：1-2》
 - b. 这将在公元 70 年应验
2. 门徒提出的问题
 - a. 他们很难接受这个现实
 - i. 殿宇在历史上象征着上帝的同在
 - ii. 它是以色列的力量与安定的象征
 - b. 他们提出的问题 《马太福音 24：3》
 - i. “请告诉我们，什么时候有这些事？”（指殿宇被毁灭）
 - ii. “你降临有什么预兆呢？”（指主的再次降临）
 - iii. “世界的末了有什么预兆呢？”（指主暂时不在世上的期间）
3. 主耶稣的回应
 - a. 祂没有直接回答这些问题
 - b. 上帝选择不将某些事显明出来 《马太福音 24：36》
 - c. 这是门徒必须学会接受的事
 - d. 更重要的挑战是他们该如何面对末期必会到来

惟有忍耐到底的必然得救

1. 主耶稣深奥的回应
 - a. 这将横跨《马太福音 24-25》
 - b. 涉及门徒如何为末期做准备的各个方面

2. 即将发生的现实
 - a. 许多迷惑与假先知 《马太福音 24: 4-5, 11》
 - b. 打仗 《马太福音 24: 6-7》
 - c. 灾难 《马太福音 24: 7-8》
 - d. 信徒遭遇患难与逼迫 《马太福音 24: 9-10》
 - e. 不法的事增多，许多人的爱心渐渐冷淡 《马太福音 24: 12》

3. 对门徒和信徒的挑战
 - a. “你们要谨慎，免得有人迷惑你们” 《马太福音 24: 4》
 - b. “总不要惊慌” 《马太福音 24: 6》
 - c. “忍耐到底” 《马太福音 24: 13》
 - i. 须要忍耐
 - ii. 那灵魂必在末了得救恩
 - d. 持续传扬天国的福音 《马太福音 24: 14》

给予大家的鼓励

1. 主耶稣
 - a. 祂当下与我们的同在虽非实体
 - b. 但祂必再次降临
 - c. 祂已经让我们做好准备来面对末期

2. 我们的责任
 - a. 不被假先知和谎言迷惑
 - b. 不因环境的挑战而惊慌
 - c. 在心思念上借着救恩，坚忍到底
 - d. 持续为主作见证

INTRODUCTION

1. New Pulpit Series – “The end of the age”
2. Reading Matthew 24-25
 - a. Learning what the Lord Jesus taught concerning the end times
 - b. Understanding how we ought to live in the end times
3. Our focus today – “He who endures to the end will be saved” Matthew 24:1-14

PROFOUND TEACHINGS CONCERNING THE END OF THE AGE

1. A prediction from the Lord Jesus concerning the temple
 - a. That the temple would be destroyed Matthew 24:1-2
 - b. This would later happen in AD 70
2. Questions from the Disciples
 - a. They found it hard to accept this reality
 - i. The temple represented the Presence of God historically
 - ii. It was a symbol of strength and wellbeing for the nation Israel
 - b. Questions raised Matthew 24:3
 - i. When will these things be? (a reference to the destruction of the temple)
 - ii. What will be the sign of Your coming? (a reference to the Lord’s Second Coming)
 - iii. And of the end of the age? (a reference to the time period of the Lord’s absence from the world)
3. The Lord Jesus

- a. He did not give a direct answer to their questions
- b. God has chosen not to reveal certain things Matthew 24:36
- c. This was something that the Disciples would have to accept
- d. The more important challenge was how they ought to face the certainty of the end times

HE WHO ENDURES TO THE END WILL BE SAVED

1. The profound response of the Lord Jesus
 - a. This would span across Matthew 24-25
 - b. Covering various aspects of how the Disciples ought to prepare for the end times
2. The reality of what is to come
 - a. Much deception and false prophets Matthew 24:4-5, 11
 - b. Wars Matthew 24:6-7
 - c. Disasters Matthew 24:7-8
 - d. Tribulation and persecution of believers Matthew 24:9-10
 - e. Lawlessness will abound, love of many will grow cold Matthew 24:12
3. The challenge of the Disciples and believers
 - a. Take heed that no one deceives you Matthew 24:4
 - b. See that you are not troubled Matthew 24:6
 - c. To endure to the end Matthew 24:13
 - i. Endurance is needed
 - ii. Salvation of the soul is at the end
 - d. To continue preaching the Gospel of the Kingdom Matthew 24:14

ENCOURAGEMENT TO US ALL

1. The Lord Jesus
 - a. He is not with us today physically
 - b. But He will come again
 - c. And He has prepared us to face these end times
2. Our part
 - a. To not be deceived by false prophets and falsehoods
 - b. To not be troubled by the challenges around us
 - c. To endure with salvation in our minds and hearts
 - d. To continue being a witness for the Lord
