马利亚所面对的诸多挑战

1. 妇女被轻视
在古时，妇女普遍不被看重
2. 贫穷的背景
 - a. 马利亚住在加利利的拿撒勒 《路加福音 1:26》
 - b. 拿撒勒甚至被加利利其他城邑所轻视
 - c. 贫穷人在社会中通常被忽略或看不起
3. 鄙视
若婚前被发现怀孕，必然会遭受极深的羞辱与蔑视。
4. 鄙视的一个例子

1 我要向祢举目，
坐在诸天上的主啊！
2 看哪，仆人的眼睛怎样望主人的手，
使女的眼睛怎样望主母的手，
我们的眼睛也照样望耶和华—我们的 神，
直到祂怜悯我们。
3 耶和华啊，求祢怜悯我们！怜悯我们！
因为我们被藐视，已经极其厌烦。
4 我们的心被那些安逸人的讥诮，
和骄傲人的藐视，已经极其厌烦。

《诗篇 123:1-4》

5. 另一个鄙视的例子

43 次日，耶稣想要往加利利去，遇见腓力，就对他说：“跟从我吧！”

44 这腓力是伯赛大人，和安得烈、彼得同城。

45 腓力找着拿但业，对他说：“摩西在律法上所写的，和众先知所记的那一位，我们遇见了，就是拿撒勒人耶稣，约瑟的儿子。”

46 拿但业对他说：“拿撒勒还能出什么好的吗？”

腓力说：“你来看！”

《约翰福音 1:43-46》

对上帝怜悯的珍惜

46 马利亚说：

“我心尊主为大；

47 我灵以 神我的救主为乐。

48 因为祂顾念祂使女的卑微；

从今以后，万代要称我有福。

49 那有权能的为我成就了大事；

祂的名为圣。

50 祂的怜悯归于敬畏祂的人，

直到世世代代。”

1. 上帝的怜悯

a. 这是马利亚特别突出的一点

b. 她深深感受到上帝的怜悯临到自己

2. 怜悯的一些具体表现

a. 上帝顾念卑微的人

i. 虽被人轻看与拒绝

ii. 上帝却恩慈地顾念她

iii. 神圣的上帝竟大大赐福了她

b. 上帝为她成就“大事”

i. 她得着天使的显现

ii. 她被拣选成为主耶稣的母亲

iii. 上帝向她所施的恩典极其奇妙、慈爱

3. 这怜悯是否只限于马利亚？
 - a. 不！
 - b. 上帝的怜悯临到一切敬畏祂的人
 - c. 这是从世世代代都成立的真理

2. 出自被上帝感动之灵魂的深处
3. 源自谦卑之心的回应
4. 是对伟大慈爱的上帝所献上的恰当赞美

MANY CHALLENGES THAT MARY FACED

1. Low regard for women

The low regard for women in the ancient days

2. Poor Background

- a) Mary lived in Nazareth, Galilee Luke 1:26a
- b) Nazareth was despised even by other cities in Galilee
- c) The poor were generally poorly regarded

3. Contempt

The contempt that they faced if they were found to be pregnant before marriage

4. An Example of Contempt

¹Unto You I lift up my eyes,
O You who dwell in the heavens.

²Behold, as the eyes of servants *look* to the hand of their masters,
As the eyes of a maid to the hand of her mistress,
So our eyes *look* to the Lord our God,
Until He has mercy on us.

³Have mercy on us, O Lord, have mercy on us!
For we are exceedingly filled with contempt.

⁴Our soul is exceedingly filled
With the scorn of those who are at ease,
With the contempt of the proud.

Psalm 123:1-4

5. Another Example of Contempt

⁴³The following day Jesus wanted to go to Galilee, and He found Philip and said to him, "Follow Me."

⁴⁴Now Philip was from Bethsaida, the city of Andrew and Peter.

⁴⁵Philip found Nathanael and said to him, "We have found Him of whom Moses in the law, and also the prophets, wrote—Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph."

⁴⁶And Nathanael said to him, "Can anything good come out of Nazareth?"

Philip said to him, "Come and see."

John 1:43-46

THE MERCY OF GOD APPRECIATED

⁴⁶ And Mary said:

"My soul magnifies the Lord,

⁴⁷ And my spirit has rejoiced in God my Savior.

⁴⁸ For He has regarded the lowly state of His maidservant;
For behold, henceforth all generations will call me blessed.

⁴⁹ For He who is mighty has done great things for me,
And holy *is* His name.

⁵⁰ And His mercy *is* on those who fear Him
From generation to generation.

Luke 1:46-50

1. The Mercy of God

- a) This was highlighted
- b) This was deeply appreciated

2. Some Expressions of Mercy

- a) God's regard for those who are in a "lowly state"
 - i) Man despised and rejected
 - ii) But God had graciously regarded her
 - iii) God is most holy and yet He had blessed her so greatly
- b) God had done great things
 - i) Mary was blessed with an angelic visit
 - ii) She was chosen to be the mother of Baby Jesus
 - iii) God was wonderfully gracious and kind

3. Was this Mercy of God restricted and confined to Mary?

- a) No!
- b) God's Mercy is on those who fear Him
- c) This is a truth that endures from generation to generation

THE MAGNIFICAT OF MARY

- 1. A grateful heartfelt and spontaneous response
- 2. A deep response of a Soul that has been touched by God
- 3. An inspired response that came from a humble heart
- 4. A fitting response to a great and wonderful God for His Mercy given
