2. 我们今天的焦点- “卖人子的人有祸了” 《马太福音 26：14-25》

加略人犹大 - 卖耶稣的人

1. 加略人犹大 《马太福音 26：14》
 - a. 他是十二门徒之一
 - b. 他们是主耶稣最亲近的门徒
 - i. 被祂招呼 《马太福音 10：1- 4》
 - ii. 被祂训练
 - iii. 被祂爱和呵护
2. 同意卖了主耶稣 《马太福音 26：14-16》
 - a. 加略人犹大主动地去见祭司长
 - b. 他提出钱来卖了主耶稣 参阅《提摩太前书 6：10》
 - i. 他同意接受所提出的三十枚银币

- ii. 在那时候，这没有什么价值
- iii. 这就是犹太的贪婪
- c. 他试图从那时起卖了主耶稣

连我知己的朋友，也用脚踢我

1. 逾越节的筵席 《马太福音 26：17》

- a. 主耶稣的门徒
 - i. 他们来到主耶稣那里
 - ii. 他们问祂要在哪里预备逾越节的筵席

b. 主耶稣的指示 《马太福音 26：18》

- i. 你们进城去，到某人那里
- ii. 对他说夫子要在他家里守逾越节
- iii. 这身份未被确认的门徒因爱主耶稣而为祂执行这事

c. 门徒遵着主耶稣所吩咐的行 《马太福音 26：19》

2. 主耶稣在逾越节里认出卖祂的人

a. 被出卖的话题 《马太福音 26：20-22》

- i. 主耶稣之前有说过关于卖祂的人
《马太福音 17：22-23》，《马太福音 20：17-19》
- ii. 然而，没有一位门徒去问祂这件事
- iii. 门徒们正吃的时候，主耶稣明明地跟他们说：“我实在告诉你们，你们中间有一个人要卖我了。”
- iv. 门徒们就甚忧愁，一个一个地问祂说：“主，是我吗？”

b. 主耶稣的回应

《马太福音 26: 23-24》

- i. 祂很仁慈地选择不指出犹大的名字

“同我蘸手在盘子里的，就是他要卖我。”

《马太福音 26: 23》

- ii. 祂了解祂要受的痛苦和死亡是上帝旨意的部分之一

“人子必要去世，正如经上指着祂所写的”

《马太福音 26: 24a》

“连我知己的朋友，我所倚靠、吃过我饭的也用脚踢我。”

《诗篇 41: 9》

- iii. 祂警告那卖人子的人有祸了

“但卖人子的人有祸了！那人不生在世上倒好。”

《马太福音 26: 24b》

c. 铁了心的犹大

《马太福音 26: 25》

- i. 他称呼主耶稣为“拉比”而不是“主”

- ii. 他厚颜无耻地问主耶稣是不是他卖耶稣

- iii. 尽管主耶稣给予他恩典和警告，他仍会进行他邪恶的计划

给予我们的重要教训

1. 了解上帝的主权旨意

- a. 犹大的背叛是上帝的旨意和计划的一部分
- b. 但这完全是加略人犹大的：
 - i. 个人决定
 - ii. 个人邪恶
 - iii. 个人责任
- c. 上帝
 - i. 祂绝对无须对人的罪负责
 - ii. 尽管人的邪恶选择和行为，上帝还是会进行祂的主权旨意

2. 爱主耶稣的问题

- a. 马利亚为了荣耀和敬拜主耶稣而付出许多 《马太福音 26： 1-13》
- b. 那未被确认的门徒为了主耶稣打开了他的家
《马太福音 26： 18-19》
- c. 加略人犹大为三十枚银币而卖了他的主和主人
《马太福音 26： 14-16》
- d. 那我们每个人呢？
 - i. 我们有多爱主？
 - ii. 我们对主的爱能从现实生活中看见吗？

INTRODUCTION

1. Pulpit Series – “The Death and Resurrection of the Lord”
 - a. Reading Matthew 26-28 and concluding the Gospel of Matthew
 - b. To learn poignant lessons concerning the death and resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ
 - c. To be challenged to find a deeper appreciation of the Lord Jesus and our salvation in Him

2. Our focus today – “Woe to that man” Matthew 26:14-25

JUDAS ISCARIOT – THE BETRAYER

1. Judas Iscariot Matthew 26:14
 - a. He was one of the twelve disciples
 - b. They were the disciples closest to the Lord Jesus
 - i. Called by Him Matthew 10:1-4
 - ii. Trained by Him
 - iii. Loved and cared for by Him

2. Agreeing to betray the Lord Jesus Matthew 26:14-16
 - a. Judas Iscariot went to the chief priests on his own initiative
 - b. He offered to betray the Lord Jesus for money cf. 1 Timothy 6:10
 - i. He agreed to the thirty pieces of silver that was offered
 - ii. This was not even of great value in those days
 - iii. Such was the greed of Judas
 - c. He sought to betray the Lord Jesus from then on

MY OWN FAMILIAR FRIEND HAS LIFTED HIS HEEL AGAINST ME

1. The Passover Meal Matthew 26:17

a. The disciples of the Lord Jesus

i. They came to the Lord Jesus

ii. They asked Him where they ought to prepare the Passover Meal

b. The instruction of the Lord Jesus Matthew 26:18

i. Go into the city to a certain man

ii. To inform this man that the Teacher will keep the Passover at his house

iii. This was an unidentified disciple who would lovingly do this for the Lord Jesus

c. The disciples did as the Lord Jesus directed Matthew 26:19

2. The Lord Jesus identifies His betrayer at the Passover Meal

a. The topic of betrayal Matthew 26:20-22

i. The Lord Jesus had previously spoken concerning His betrayal
Matthew 17:22-23, Matthew 20:17-19

ii. Yet none of the disciples sought to ask Him about this

iii. The Lord Jesus plainly said to them as they were eating

“Assuredly, I say to you, one of you will betray Me.”

iv. The disciples became exceedingly sorrowful and each asked “Lord, is it I?”

b. The response of the Lord Jesus Matthew 26:23-24

i. He most graciously chose not to identify Judas by name

“He who dipped his hand with Me in the dish will betray Me.”
Matthew 26:23

ii. He understood this His suffering and death was part of God’s will

“The Son of Man indeed goes just as it is written of Him”
Matthew 26:24a

“Even my own familiar friend in whom I trusted, who ate my bread, has
lifted up his heel against me.”
Psalm 41:9

iii. He warned of the woe to come to the man who would betray Him

“But woe to that man by whom the Son of Man is betrayed! It would
have been good for that man if he had not been born.”
Matthew 26:24b

c. The hardened heart of Judas Matthew 26:25

i. He addressed the Lord Jesus as “Rabbi” rather than “Lord”

ii. He brazenly asked the Lord Jesus if it was him

iii. He would proceed with his evil plan despite the grace and warning of the
Lord Jesus

IMPORTANT LESSONS FOR US ALL

1. Understanding God’s sovereign will

a. The betrayal of Judas was part of God’s will and plan

b. But it entirely was Judas Iscariot’s

i. Personal decision

ii. Personal wickedness

iii. Personal responsibility

c. God

i. He is not in any way responsible for the sins of man

ii. His sovereign will still carry on despite the wicked choices and actions of
man

2. A question of love for the Lord Jesus

- a. Mary gave much in honor and worship of the Lord Jesus Matthew 26:1-13
- b. The unidentified disciple opened His home for the Lord Jesus
Matthew 26:18-19
- c. Judas Iscariot betrayed His Lord and Master for thirty pieces of silver
Matthew 26:14-16
- d. How about each of us?
 - i. How much do we love the Lord?
 - ii. Is the reality of our love for the Lord seen in our lives?
