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介绍

2. 我们今天的焦点 — “我立约的血” 《马太福音 26：26 - 30》

新约的应许

1. 旧约
 - a. 建立在上帝的律法上
 - b. 上帝的子民本当认识并遵守祂的律法
 - c. 这样便会得着上帝的赐福
 - d. 可悲的是，上帝的子民屡次违背祂的约

2. 上帝所应许的新约
 - a. 藉着先知耶利米《耶利米书 31：31 - 34》
 - b. 新约的主要特点：
 - i. “我要……另立新约”
 - ii. “不像……我与他们所立的（旧）约，……他们却背了我的约”
 - iii. “我要将我的律法放在他们里面，写在他们心上”
 - iv. “我要作他们的神，他们要作我的子民”
 - v. “我要赦免他们的罪孽，不再记念他们的罪恶”

圣餐

1. 主耶稣

- a. 祂将通过自己的死成就并开启新约
- b. 祂设立了圣餐
 - i. 帮助门徒明白赦罪与救恩是通过祂的死而来
 - ii. 教导门徒与祂相交的意义
 - iii. 帮助门徒不断记念祂的爱与牺牲

2. 圣餐

- a. 主耶稣的身体《马太福音 26: 26》
 - i. 饼象征祂为我们舍的身体
 - ii. 门徒要藉着祂所受的苦领受主的爱
 - b. 主耶稣的血《马太福音 26: 27 - 28》
 - i. 杯象征祂立新约的血，为使罪得赦而流
 - ii. 门徒要藉着祂的宝血领受主的洁净与救恩
 - c. 天国的应许《马太福音 26: 29》
 - i. 门徒将来有一天会在天国与主耶稣同在
 - ii. 在天父的国度里将有甜美的相交
3. 与门徒特别且最后的崇拜时光《马太福音 26: 30》
- a. 在祂受苦和受死之前
 - b. 表现出对天父旨意的信靠

给予我们的重要教训

- 1. 珍惜我们在基督里所得的救恩
 - a. 这是上帝所策划并应许的
 - b. 是通过基督的宝血所得取的
- 2. 珍惜我们为何守住圣餐
 - a. 为的是记念祂的受苦和受死
 - b. 与祂的相交与认同中
- 3. 被主临近死亡时的榜样而受挑战
 - a. 崇拜
 - b. 顺服

Text: Matthew 26:26-30

INTRODUCTION

1. Pulpit Series – “The Death and Resurrection of the Lord”
 - a. Reading Matthew 26-28 and concluding the Gospel of Matthew
 - b. To learn poignant lessons concerning the death and resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ
 - c. To be challenged to find a deeper appreciation of the Lord Jesus and our salvation in Him
2. Our focus today – “My blood of the New Covenant” Matthew 26:26-30

THE PROMISE OF A NEW COVENANT

1. The Old Covenant
 - a. It was based on the laws of God
 - b. God’s people were meant to know and keep His laws
 - c. Therein would be God’s blessings
 - d. Sadly, God’s people kept breaking His covenant
2. God’s promise of a New Covenant
 - a. Through the prophet Jeremiah Jeremiah 31:31-34
 - b. Key features of the New Covenant
 - i. “I will make a new covenant”

- ii. "Not according to the (old) covenant... which they broke"
- iii. "I will put My law in their hearts, and write it upon their hearts"
- iv. "I will be their God, and they shall be My people"
- v. "I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more"

THE LORD'S SUPPER

1. The Lord Jesus

- a. He would fulfil and usher in the New Covenant through His death
- b. He instituted the Lord's Supper
 - i. To help His disciples understand the forgiveness and salvation that comes through His death
 - ii. To teach His disciples the significance of communion with Him
 - iii. To help His disciples continually remember His love and sacrifice

2. The Lord's Supper

- a. The body of the Lord Jesus Matthew 26:26
 - i. The bread symbolizes His body given for us
 - ii. The disciples were to partake of the Lord's love through His suffering
- b. The blood of the Lord Jesus Matthew 26:27-28
 - i. The cup symbolizes the blood of the New Covenant shed for the remission of sins
 - ii. The disciples were to partake of the Lord's cleansing and salvation through His blood
- c. The promise of Heaven Matthew 26:29
 - i. The disciples will be with the Lord Jesus one day in Heaven

- ii. There will be sweet communion in the Father's kingdom
- 3. A special and final moment of worship with the disciples Matthew 26:30
 - a. Before His suffering and death
 - b. Exercising trust in the Father's Will

IMPORTANT LESSONS FOR US ALL

1. To cherish the salvation that we have in Christ
 - a. Planned and promised
 - b. Purchased with the blood of Christ
2. To appreciate why we observe the Lord's Supper
 - a. In remembrance of His suffering and death
 - b. In communion and identification with Him
3. To be challenged by the Lord's Example as He approached His death
 - a. Worship
 - b. Obedience
 - c. Faith
