2. 我们今天的焦点 — “这真是神的儿子了” 《马太福音 27：27 - 54》

上帝之子所受的苦楚

1. 在预言中主耶稣的苦楚
 - a. 是出自先知以赛亚的预言 《以赛亚书 53：3-5》
 - i. 祂被藐视，被人厌弃
 - ii. 被上帝击打苦待了
 - iii. 受害与压伤
 - b. 理由
 - i. 担当我们的忧患
 - ii. 背负我们的痛苦
 - iii. 为我们的过犯受害
 - iv. 为我们的罪孽压伤
 - v. 因祂受的刑罚我们得平安
 - vi. 因祂受的鞭伤我们得医治（从罪恶中）

2. 马太记载了主耶稣的苦楚
 - a. 兵士们戏弄、打主耶稣 《马太福音 27：27 - 31》
 - i. 他们给祂穿上一件朱红色袍子
 - ii. 他们用荆棘编做冠冕，戴在祂头上
 - iii. 他们戏弄祂，说：“恭喜，犹太人的王啊！”
 - b. 被钉在十字架上 《马太福音 27：35》

- i. 这是最痛苦的死刑方式
- ii. 这是处置最可恶的犯人和强盗的
- iii. 主耶稣虽然无罪，却被钉在十字架上
- c. 拈阄分主耶稣的衣服
- d. 不断地被以下的人戏弄
 - i. 路过的人
 - ii. 祭司长、文士和长老
 - iii. 就连在祂旁边被钉在十字架的强盗

上帝之子的死

1. 主耶稣的死 《马太福音 27：45-50》
 - a. 祂被钉在十字架上
 - i. 三个小时（从午正到申初）
 - ii. 遍地都黑暗了
 - b. 主耶稣表达了痛苦与忧患
“以利！以利！拉马撒巴各大尼？”就是说：“我的神！我的神！为什么离弃我？”
 - i. 这不是遗憾、悲伤或愤怒的哭喊
 - ii. 而是祂因肉体所承受的痛与苦楚所发出的呐喊
 - c. 主耶稣在十字架上死，气就断了（信靠天父）

2. 随着主耶稣的死意义重大的神迹异能 《马太福音 27：51-54》
 - a. 殿里的幔子从上到下裂为两半
 - i. 幔子隔离了罪人和上帝神圣的面
 - ii. 因基督的死，我们现在得以来到上帝面前
 - b. 地震象征上帝神圣的审判
 - c. 坟墓也开了，已睡圣徒起来
 - i. 象征基督战胜罪恶与死亡
 - ii. 象征上帝能够叫人复活以及给予生命的大能
 - d. 百夫长宣称基督就是上帝的儿子，象征上帝救恩的计划包括外邦人

我们对上帝的儿子的反应

1. 主耶稣为我们承受的
 - a. 苦楚
 - b. 几乎到死

2. 主耶稣献给我们的
 - a. 与上帝和好
 - b. 丰盛和永恒的生命

3. 我们的反应会是什么呢？

INTRODUCTION

1. Pulpit Series – “The Death and Resurrection of the Lord”
 - a. Reading Matthew 26-28 and concluding the Gospel of Matthew
 - b. To learn poignant lessons concerning the death and resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ
 - c. To be challenged to find a deeper appreciation of the Lord Jesus and our salvation in Him

2. Our focus today – “Truly this was the Son of God” Matthew 27:27-54

THE SUFFERING OF THE SON OF GOD

1. The suffering of the Lord Jesus prophesied
 - a. It was prophesied by the prophet Isaiah Isaiah 53:3-5
 - i. Despised and rejected by men
 - ii. Smitten by God and afflicted
 - iii. Wounded and bruised

b. Reasons

- i. To bear our griefs
- ii. To carry our sorrows
- iii. Wounded for our transgressions
- iv. Bruised for our iniquities
- v. Chastisement for our peace was upon Him
- vi. By His stripes we are healed (from sin)

2. The suffering of the Lord Jesus recorded by Matthew

a. Mocked and struck by the soldiers Matthew 27:27-31

- i. They put a scarlet robe on Him
- ii. They twisted a crown of thorns and put it on His head
- iii. They mocked Him as they said, "Hail, King of the Jews"

b. Crucified on the cross Matthew 27:35

- i. This was a most painful method of execution
- ii. It was reserved for the worst of criminals and robbers
- iii. Yet the Lord Jesus was crucified even though He had no sin

c. Garments divided

d. Mocked repeatedly

- i. By those who passed by
- ii. By the chief priests, scribes, elders
- iii. Even by the robbers who were crucified with Him

THE DEATH OF THE SON OF GOD

1. The death of the Lord Jesus Matthew 27:45-50

- a. He was crucified on the cross
 - i. For three hours (from the sixth to ninth hour)
 - ii. Darkness came upon the land
- b. The pain and sorrow of the Lord Jesus expressed

“Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani?” that is, “My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?”

- i. Not a cry of regret or sadness or anger
 - ii. But a cry of suffering and pain He endured in human form
- c. The Lord Jesus died on the cross and yielded up His spirit (trusting in the Father)

2. The significance sign-miracles that accompanied His death Matthew 27:51-54

- a. The veil of the temple torn in two
 - i. The veil separated sinful man from the holy presence of God
 - ii. Christ’s death has now brought about access to God
- b. The earthquake signifying God’s divine judgement
- c. The graves being opened and saints raised
 - i. Signifying Christ’ victory over sin and death
 - ii. Signifying God’s power to resurrect and give life
- d. The centurion professing Christ as the Son of God signifying that Gentiles are included in God’s plan of salvation
