介绍

1. 我们的证道系列 — “主的受难与复活”
 - a. 阅读《马太福音 26 - 28》，和总结《马太福音》
 - b. 学习关于主耶稣基督受难与复活那深深打动人心的教训
 - c. 受挑战来寻求对主耶稣及祂的救恩更深刻的珍惜

2. 我们今天的焦点 — “祂复活了” 《马太福音 27：62-66， 28：1-10》

封了主的坟墓

1. 主耶稣
 - a. 祂为人的罪而死在十字架上 《马太福音 27：50》
 - b. 祂葬在亚利马太的约瑟所准备的新的坟墓 《马太福音 27：57-61》
 - c. 主耶稣之前说过关于祂的受难，和三日后的复活 《马太福音 16：21， 17：22-23， 20：18-19》

2. 祭司长和法利赛人 《马太福音 27：62-66》
 - a. 是他们计划杀害主耶稣
 - b. 他们现在试图继续反对祂和祂的话语
 - c. 他们记得主耶稣说过关于三日后复活的事
 - i. 他们试图反对主耶稣的话语
 - ii. 他们错误的以为门徒会来偷祂的身体
 - iii. 他们带着看守的兵同，又封了石头，将坟墓把守妥当

祂复活了

1. 主耶稣的复活
 - a. 安息日过后/受难后的第三日 《马太福音 28：1-4》

- i. 抹大拉的马利亚和那个马利亚来到坟墓
 - ii. 主的使者从天上下来，把封了坟墓的石头滚开
 - iii. 看守的人看到主的天使而感到非常害怕
 - b. 天使对妇女说的话 《马太福音 28： 5-7》
 - i. 不要害怕
 - ii. 主耶稣已从死里复活，所以祂不在坟墓里
 - iii. 到加利利去并会看见祂
- 2. 与复活的主的特别相遇
 - a. 妇女 《马太福音 28： 8》
 - i. 她们感到极大的欢喜
 - ii. 她们跑去报给祂的门徒
 - b. 复活的主耶稣向她们显现 《马太福音 28： 9-10》
 - i. 当她们在路上
 - ii. 她们上前抱住祂的脚拜祂
 - iii. 她们受鼓励不要害怕，反而去弟兄那里为复活的主做见证

给予我们的鼓励

- 1. 上帝的大能
 - a. 将封了的坟墓打开 《胜于人的大能》
 - b. 肯定了基督的牺牲以及把祂从死里复活 《胜于罪孽和死亡的大能》
 - c. 将忧伤转为喜乐和崇拜 《改变生命的大能》
- 2. 我们的鼓励
 - a. 根据上帝的话语，信靠上帝的大能
 - b. 把盼望建立在复活的救主耶稣里
 - c. 向罪看自己是死的，向上帝看自己是活的 《罗马书 6： 11》

Text: Matthew 27:62-66, 28:1-10

INTRODUCTION

1. Pulpit Series – “The Death and Resurrection of the Lord”
 - a. Reading Matthew 26-28 and concluding the Gospel of Matthew
 - b. To learn poignant lessons concerning the death and resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ
 - c. To be challenged to find a deeper appreciation of the Lord Jesus and our salvation in Him
2. Our focus today – “He is risen” Matthew 27:62-66, 28:1-10

THE SEALING OF THE LORD’S TOMB

1. The Lord Jesus
 - a. He died on the cross for the sins of man Matthew 27:50
 - b. He had been buried in the new tomb prepared by Joseph of Arimathea
Matthew 27:57-61
 - c. The Lord Jesus had previously spoken of His death and His resurrection on the third day Matthew 16:21, 17:22-23, 20:18-19
2. The chief priests and Pharisees Matthew 27:62-66
 - a. They were the ones who had plotted to kill the Lord Jesus
 - b. They now sought to continue opposing Him and His Word
 - c. They remembered what the Lord Jesus said concerning rising after three days
 - i. They sought to oppose the word of the Lord Jesus
 - ii. They wrongly assumed that the disciples would come and steal His body
 - iii. They secured the tomb by setting guards and sealing the stone

HE IS RISEN

1. The resurrection of the Lord Jesus
 - a. After the Sabbath / on the third day of His death Matthew 28:1-4
 - i. Mary Magdalene and the other Mary came to the tomb
 - ii. An angel of the Lord descended from heaven and rolled the stone that sealed the tomb
 - iii. The guards feared greatly when they saw the angel
 - b. The word of the angel to the women Matthew 28:5-7
 - i. To not be afraid
 - ii. The Lord Jesus has risen from the dead and is no longer here in the tomb
 - iii. To go to Galilee and there they will see Him
2. A most special encounter with the Risen Lord
 - a. The women Matthew 28:8
 - i. They experienced great joy
 - ii. They ran to bring His disciples word
 - b. The Risen Lord Jesus appears to them Matthew 28:9-10
 - i. While they were on their way
 - ii. They held Him by the feet and worshipped Him
 - iii. They were encouraged to not fear and to bear witness of the Risen Lord to the brethren

ENCOURAGEMENT TO US ALL

1. The power of God appreciated

- a. In opening the sealed tomb (power over man)
 - b. In affirming Christ's sacrifice and raising Him from the dead (power over sin and death)
 - c. In turning mourning to joy and worship (power to transform lives)
2. Our encouragement
- a. To have faith in the power of God according to His Word
 - b. To place our hope in our Risen Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ
 - c. To reckon ourselves dead to sin and alive to God Romans 6:11
