1. 我们的证道系列 — “主的受难与复活”
 - a. 阅读《马太福音 26 - 28》，和总结《马太福音》
 - b. 学习关于主耶稣基督受难与复活那深深打动人心的教训
 - c. 受挑战来寻求对主耶稣及祂的救恩更深刻的珍惜

2. 我们今天的焦点 — “压制真理” 《马太福音 28：11-15》

关于主耶稣复活的真理

1. 主耶稣的复活
 - a. 如祂所说的，三日后祂复活了
 - b. 祂的复活被见证了
 - i. 被派去看守坟墓的兵丁们见证了 《马太福音 28:1-4》
 - ii. 被来到坟墓并随后遇见祂的妇女们见证了 《马太福音 28:5-9》

2. 主耶稣复活的消息
 - a. 天使吩咐妇女们去告诉门徒，祂已经从死里复活了 《马太福音 28:7》
 - b. 妇女们也受主耶稣亲自吩咐 《马太福音 28:10》
 - i. 去告诉祂的弟兄们，祂已复活
 - ii. 祂的弟兄们要在加利利见祂

3. 主耶稣将受死并复活
 - a. 这是主耶稣曾预言过的 《马太福音 16:21，17：22-23，20:18-19》
 - b. 如今应验了 《马太福音 28:11-15》
 - c. 这真理本是要与所有人分享的

祭司长和长老压制真理

1. 奉命看守主坟墓的兵丁们的反应
 - a. 他们看见天使打开坟墓，被吓得浑身乱战 《马太福音 28:4》
 - b. 他们进城去，将所经历的一切事都报给祭司长 《马太福音 28:11》

2. 祭司长和长老们压制真理的恶谋 《马太福音 28:12-14》
 - a. 祭司长和长老们聚集商议
 - b. 他们拿许多银钱给兵丁
 - i. 撒关于空坟墓的谎
 - ii. 否认主耶稣的复活
 - iii. 谎称是门徒把祂的身体偷去了- 这与他们之前的惧怕自相矛盾 《马太福音 27:62-66》
 - c. 他们向兵丁保证，若这谎言传到巡抚耳中，他们会保兵丁无事

3. 随之而来的不幸后果 《马太福音 28:15》
 - a. 兵丁受了钱，就照所嘱咐他们的去行
 - b. 关于主耶稣复活的真理被压制，被换成了谎言
 - c. 这谎言就被传说，直到“今日”
 - i. 多年后（在马太写作时）
 - ii. 也适用于今日（数世纪后）

给予我们的重要教训

1. 真理
 - a. 可以被压制，换成谎言
 - b. 可上帝必会审判一切邪恶与虚假的 《罗马书 1:18, 24-25》
 - c. 基督复活的真理不会被谎言和虚假打败！

2. 我们的挑战
 - a. 《以弗所书 4:11-16》
 - i. 上帝给予我们牧师和教师们的帮助
 - ii. 让我们众人在真道上同归于一，认识神的儿子
 - iii. 让我们不中了人的诡计和欺骗的法术
 - iv. 让我们用爱心说诚实话
 - b. 《以弗所书 6:10-20》
 - i. 我们与属灵气的争战
 - ii. 我们要穿戴上帝所赐的全副军装
 - iii. 我们要在此警醒不倦，为众圣徒祈求

iv. 我们要放胆开口讲明福音的奥秘

INTRODUCTION

3. Pulpit Series – “The Death and Resurrection of the Lord”
 - a. Reading Matthew 26-28 and concluding the Gospel of Matthew
 - b. To learn poignant lessons concerning the death and resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ
 - c. To be challenged to find a deeper appreciation of the Lord Jesus and our salvation in Him
4. Our focus today – “The suppression of the truth” Matthew 28:11-15

THE TRUTH CONCERNING THE RESURRECTION OF THE LORD JESUS

4. The resurrection of the Lord Jesus
 - a. He rose after three days as He said
 - b. His resurrection was witnessed
 - i. By the guards who were tasked to secure His tomb Matthew 28:1-4
 - ii. By the women who came by His tomb and met Him afterward Matthew 28:5-9
5. The news of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus
 - a. The women were instructed by the angel to tell the Disciples that He is risen from the dead Matthew 28:7
 - b. The women were also instructed by the Lord Jesus Himself Matthew 28:10
 - i. To tell His brethren that He is risen
 - ii. That His brethren would see Him in Galilee

6. That the Lord Jesus would die and rise again
 - a. It was predicted by the Lord Jesus Matthew 16:21, 17:22-23, 20:18-19
 - b. It was now fulfilled Matthew 28:11-15
 - c. It was meant to be shared to all

THE SUPPRESSION OF THE TRUTH BY THE CHIEF PRIESTS AND ELDERS

4. The reaction of the guards who were meant to guard the Lord's tomb
 - a. Great fear came upon them when they saw an angel open the tomb
Matthew 28:4
 - b. They came into the city and reported to the chief priests all that happened
Matthew 28:11
5. The evil plot of the chief priests and elders to suppress the truth Matthew 28:12-14
 - a. The chief priests and elders consulted together
 - b. They bribed the soldiers with a large sum of money
 - i. To lie about the empty tomb
 - ii. To deny the resurrection of the Lord Jesus
 - iii. To lie that the disciples had taken His body - in contradiction to what they earlier feared cf. Matthew 27:62-66
 - c. They assured the soldiers of protection from the governor for spreading this lie
6. The unfortunate consequences that followed Matthew 28:15
 - a. The soldiers took the money and did the evil they were instructed
 - b. The truth concerning the Risen Lord Jesus was suppressed and exchanged for the lie
 - c. The lie continued to spread until "this day"
 - i. Years later (at the time of Matthew's writing)

ii. Also applicable to today (centuries later)

IMPORTANT LESSONS FOR US ALL

3. Truth

- a. It can be suppressed and exchanged for the lie
- b. But God will judge all evil and falsehood Romans 1:18, 24-25
- c. The truth concerning the resurrection of Christ cannot be defeated by lies and falsehood!

4. Our challenge

- a. Ephesians 4:11-16
 - i. God has given us pastors and teachers to help
 - ii. To build us up in the unity of faith and knowledge of His Son
 - iii. That we should not be carried about by trickery and deceit
 - iv. That we may speak the truth in love
- b. Ephesians 6:10-20
 - i. We wrestle against spiritual forces
 - ii. Our part to take up the whole armor of God
 - iii. To be watchful with perseverance and supplication
 - iv. To speak boldly and make known the mystery of the gospel
