《诗篇5》的背景

1. 诗篇的上标（或称标题）

“大卫的诗，交于伶长。用吹的乐器。”
2. 这是大卫所写的一首给伶长在公共崇拜的诗篇
3. 一首信靠上帝的诗篇
4. 也称为“早晨的诗篇”

在早晨仰望上帝

1. 《诗篇4》
 - a. “傍晚”的诗篇
 - b. 在困苦中向上帝呼求
 - c. 在上帝里找到平安入睡

2. 《诗篇5》
 - a. 在早晨里转向上帝 《诗篇5:1-2》
 - i. 在祷告中

- ii. 在心思中
- iii. 向最个人的王与神
- b. 大卫的意识决定 《诗篇 5:3》
 - i. 在早晨把声音扬给上帝
 - ii. 向上帝陈明他的心意
 - iii. 向上帝警醒

大卫转向上帝的沉思

1. 上帝的圣洁 《诗篇 5:4-6》
 - a. 祂不喜悦恶事与恶人
 - b. 祂抗议狂傲与作孽的人
 - c. 祂憎恶谎言，暴力，诡诈
2. 崇拜上帝 《诗篇 5:7》
 - a. “至于我”
 - i. 大卫因邪恶的敌人而挣扎
 - ii. 但他下定决心不效法那些作恶的人
 - b. 寻求给予崇拜
 - i. 在祂丰盛的慈爱里
 - ii. 以虔诚与敬畏的心
3. 上帝的带领 《诗篇 5:8-10》
 - a. 在上帝的公义中寻求祂的带领和明确的引导（而不是大卫个人的义）
 - b. 寻求上帝的审判
 - i. 那些说恶言的人
 - ii. 那些犯罪和背叛上帝的人

信靠上帝美好的喜乐

1. 凡投靠上帝 《诗篇 5:11-12》
 - a. 他们也是那些爱祂的名的人
 - b. 他们也是那些正直地为主而活的“义人”
 - c. 他们将在上帝里喜乐并时常欢呼

2. 理由
 - a. 上帝将护庇
 - b. 上帝将赐福
 - c. 上帝将用恩惠如同盾牌四面护卫他们

 - a. 在沉思中

 - a. 信靠的心

1. Pulpit Series – “The Davidic Psalms”
 - a. Reading selected Davidic Psalms
 - b. Understanding the context of each Psalm and what David was going through
 - c. Learning lessons about
 - i. God
 - ii. Exercising faith in God
2. Our focus today – “My voice You shall hear in the morning” Psalm 5

THE CONTEXT OF PSALM 5

1. Superscription (Title of the Psalm)
 “To the Chief Musician. With flutes. A Psalm of David.”
2. A Psalm written by David given to the Chief Musician for public worship
3. A Psalm of trust in God
4. Also known as the “Morning Psalm”

LOOKING UP TO GOD IN THE MORNING

1. Psalm 4
 - a. The “Evening” Psalm
 - b. Crying out to God in distress
 - c. Finding peace in God to sleep
2. Psalm 5
 - a. Turning to God in the morning Psalm 5:1-2
 - i. In prayer
 - ii. In meditation
 - iii. To a most personal King and God
 - b. David’s conscious decision Psalm 5:3
 - i. To lift up his voice to God in the morning
 - ii. To direct his voice to God
 - iii. To look up to God

DAVID'S MEDITATION AS HE TURNED TO GOD

1. The holiness of God Psalm 5:4-6
 - a. He does not delight in wickedness and evil
 - b. He resists the boastful and workers of iniquity
 - c. He is against falsehood, violence, deceit

2. The worship of God Psalm 5:7
 - a. *"But as for me"*
 - i. David struggled with wicked enemies
 - ii. But he made a conscious commitment to not be like those who are evil
 - b. Seeking to offer worship
 - i. In the multitude of His mercy
 - ii. With fear and reverence

3. The leading of God Psalm 5:8-10
 - a. Seeking God's leading and clarity in His righteousness (rather than David's own righteousness)
 - b. Seeking God's judgement against
 - i. Those who speak evil
 - ii. Those who transgress and rebel against God

THE WONDERFUL JOY OF TRUSTING IN GOD

1. Those who trust in God Psalm 5:11-12
 - a. They are also those who love His Name
 - b. They are also "the righteous" who seek to live righteously for the Lord

- c. They will rejoice in God and shout for joy
2. Reasons
- a. God will defend
 - b. God will bless
 - c. God will graciously surround them as with a shield

ENCOURAGEMENT TO US ALL

1. Learning to pray to God in the morning
 - a. In meditation
 - b. In worship
2. Cultivating a heart of
 - a. Trust
 - b. Love
 - c. Righteousness
3. Experiencing the joy of trusting the Lord in the ups and downs of life
