《诗篇8》的背景

1. 诗篇上标（主题）：“*大卫的诗，交于伶长。用迦特乐器。*”
2. 这是大卫王写的诗篇
 - a. 交托给伶长（音乐师首领）用在崇拜
 - b. 大卫没提供其他的背景
 - c. 它扑捉了大卫王的沉思：
 - i. 有关上帝的美好
 - ii. 上帝与世人的关系

上帝的美妙

1. 上帝的名 《诗篇8》
 - a. 上帝的名表达：
 - i. 祂的身份
 - ii. 祂的个性
 - iii. 祂的全能
 - iv. 祂的事功
2. 大卫赞美上帝的名 《诗篇8:1》
 - a. 在全地何其美
 - b. 荣耀彰显于天

3. 上帝的美展现在祂的创造里
 - a. 婴孩和吃奶的婴儿 《诗篇 8:2》
 - i. 他们还幼小，削弱
 - ii. 但从他们口中能赞美上帝！
 - iii. 上帝建立了（潜能）力量，有一天会在他们生命中成全
 - iv. 甚至上帝的仇敌都闭口无言
 - b. 上帝造的天，月亮星宿 《诗篇 8:3》
 - i. 无比的美妙，深奥
 - ii. 人只能观看，却没能完全理解
 - iii. 这只不过是上帝“指头”所造的

瞻仰上帝对世人的关爱

1. 上帝对世人关爱的特别见解
2. 人与上帝所造的一切万物相比是多么微不足道 《诗篇 8:3-4》
 - a. 比起上帝的创造
 - i. 天
 - ii. 月亮
 - iii. 星宿
 - b. 大卫提的问题非常恰当 - “人算什么”
3. 但上帝却关爱他
 - a. 上帝竟顾念他 《诗篇 8:4》
 - b. 上帝眷顾人
 - c. 上帝赐他冠冕 《诗篇 8:5》
 - i. 荣耀尊贵为冠冕
 - ii. 即使他比天使微小
 - d. 上帝派人管理祂手所造的 《诗篇 8:6-8》
 - i. 一切都服在人的脚下
 - ii. 田野的兽
 - iii. 空中的鸟
 - iv. 海里的鱼
4. 《诗篇 8》 的结论
 - a. 大卫沉思最适当的回应
 - b. 称颂上帝的名 《诗篇 8:9》

- i. 谦卑地称颂
- ii. 诚心地称颂

 - i. God
 - ii. Exercising faith in God
2. Our focus today – “What is man that You are mindful of him?” Psalm 8

THE CONTEXT OF PSALM 8

1. Superscription (Title of the Psalm)

“To the Chief Musician. On the instrument of Gath. A Psalm of David.”

2. A Psalm written David
 - a. Presented to the Chief Musician for worship
 - b. No specific context was noted by David
 - c. It captured David's meditation on
 - i. The excellence of God
 - ii. God's relationship with man

THE EXCELLENCE OF GOD

1. The Name of God Psalm 8:1
 - a. It represents who He is
 - i. Who He is
 - ii. His Character
 - iii. His Power
 - iv. His Work
2. David praise of the Name of God Psalm 8:1
 - a. Excellent in all the earth
 - b. Glorious above the heavens
3. The excellence of God revealed in His Creation
 - a. Babes and nursing infants Psalm 8:2
 - i. They are weak and small
 - ii. Yet out of their mouths can come praise of God!
 - iii. God has ordained strength (potential) that can be realized in their lives one day
 - iv. Even the enemies of God cannot but be silenced at the excellence of God's Creation

- b. The heavens, the moon and the stars Psalm 8:3
 - i. Beautiful and profound beyond measure
 - ii. Man can only consider but not fully comprehend
 - iii. These are but the work of God's "fingers"

APPRECIATING GOD'S LOVE AND CARE FOR MAN

1. A most special insight concerning God's care for man
2. Man is small in comparison to all that God has created Psalm 8:3-4
 - a. In comparison to God's Creation
 - i. The heavens
 - ii. The moon
 - iii. The stars
 - b. David rightly raises the question – what is man?
3. Yet God has wonderfully cared for man
 - a. God is mindful of man Psalm 8:4
 - b. God visits and gives attention to man
 - c. God has crowned man Psalm 8:5
 - i. With glory and honor
 - ii. Despite being even lower than the angels
 - d. God has given man dominion over His works Psalm 8:6-8
 - i. All things under man's feet
 - ii. The animals of the field
 - iii. The birds of the air
 - iv. The fish of the sea

4. The conclusion of Psalm 8

- a. A most fitting response from David's meditation
- b. To give praise once again for the excellence of the Name of God Psalm 8:9
 - i. Humbly
 - ii. Heartfelt
