《诗篇9》的背景

1. 诗篇的上标（或称标题）

“大卫的诗，交于伶长。调用慕拉便。”
2. 大卫写的一首诗篇，交给伶长在公共崇拜使用
3. 调用慕拉便（或译“儿子去世”）
 - a. 未进一步说明为何提及“慕拉便”
 - b. 可能是为了表达哀叹与悲伤
4. 《诗篇9》的焦点 - 上帝公义的审判

立志赞美

1. “我要一心称谢耶和华” 《诗篇9:1-2》
 - a. “一心称谢”
 - b. “传扬祢一切奇妙的作为”
 - c. “因祢欢喜快乐”

- d. “至高者啊，我要歌颂祢的名”
- 2. 原因 《诗篇 9:3-4》
 - a. 回想个人的困境 《诗篇 9:3-4》
 - i. 仇敌确实存在
 - ii. 但上帝已保护，并按公义施行审判
 - b. 回想国家的困境 《诗篇 9:5-6》
 - i. 邪恶的外邦确实存在
 - ii. 但上帝已斥责并灭绝他们

立志信靠神

- 1. “唯耶和华坐着为王” 《诗篇 9:7-8》
 - a. 直到永远
 - b. 祂已经为审判设摆祂的宝座
 - c. 祂要按公义审判世界
- 2. 相信祂看顾并保护义人 《诗篇 9:9-10》
 - a. 给受欺压的人做高台
 - b. 在患难的时候做高台
 - c. 祂没有离弃寻求祂、倚靠祂的人
 - d. 祂纪念义人，也纪念那些谦卑向祂呼求的人
- 3. 劝勉的话 《诗篇 9:11-12》
 - a. 要向上帝歌颂
 - b. 在万民中宣扬祂的作为
 - c. 要信靠祂
 - i. 祂必追讨流人血之罪
 - ii. 纪念受屈的人
 - iii. 祂必不忘记谦卑人的呼求

恳求神的怜悯

- 1. 大卫对上帝的祈求 《诗篇 9:13》
 - a. 怜恤他
 - b. 顾念那恨他的人所加给他的困苦
 - c. 将他从死门提拔起来

2. 大卫的立志 《诗篇 9:14》
 - a. 要在众人中赞美上帝
 - b. 要因上帝的救恩欢乐

3. 大卫的默想 《诗篇 9:15-18》
 - a. 恶劣的外邦人
 - i. 他们必被自己手所做的缠住
 - ii. 上帝必向他们施行审判
 - b. 义人
 - i. 穷乏人必不永久被上帝忘
 - ii. 困苦人的指望必不永远落空

4. 大卫的信心与倚靠 《诗篇 9:19-20》
 - a. 求上帝兴起施行审判
 - b. 对恶人的审判
 - i. 不让恶人得胜
 - ii. 使他们受上帝的审判
 - iii. 使他们敬畏上帝，在祂面前谦卑

 - a. 祂是公义的审判者
 - b. 祂并不缺席于人生的困境中

2. Our focus today – “He shall judge the world in righteousness” Psalm 9

THE CONTEXT OF PSALM 9

1. Superscription (Title of the Psalm)

To the Chief Musician. To the tune of “Death of the Son.” A Psalm of David.
2. A Psalm written by David and presented to the Chief Musician for worship
3. Written to the tune of “Death of the Son”
 - a. No further details provided as to why “Death of the Son” was referenced
 - b. Possibly to express lament and sorrow
4. Focus of Psalm 9 - the righteous judgement of God

DETERMINING TO GIVE PRAISE

3. “I will praise You, O LORD” Psalm 9:1-2
 - a. “With my whole heart”
 - b. “Tell of all Your marvelous works”
 - c. “Rejoice in You”

d. "Sing praise to your name, O Most High"

4. Reasons Psalm 9:3-4

a. Recalling problems at a personal level Psalm 9:3-4

i. Enemies exist

ii. But God has protected and judged in righteousness

b. Recalling problems at a national level Psalm 9:5-6

i. Wicked nations exist

ii. But God has rebuked and destroyed them

DETERMINING TO TRUST IN GOD

4. That He is Sovereign over all Psalm 9:7-8

a. He endures forever

b. He has prepared His throne for judgement

c. He shall judge the world in righteousness

5. That He will watch over and protect the righteous Psalm 9:9-10

a. He is a refuge for those oppressed by the wicked

b. He is a refuge in times of trouble

c. He will not forsake the righteous who seek Him and trust in Him

d. He remembers the righteous and those who cry out to Him in humility

6. A word of exhortation Psalm 9:11-12

a. To sing praises to the LORD

b. To declare His deeds among the people

c. To trust in Him

i. He will avenge

- ii. He will remember
- iii. He will not forget the cry of the humble

PLEADING FOR GOD'S MERCY

1. David's personal plea Psalm 9:13
 - a. To have mercy on him
 - b. To consider his trouble from those who hate him
 - c. To lift him up from the gates of death
2. David's personal commitment Psalm 9:14
 - a. To praise the LORD among all
 - b. To rejoice in His salvation
3. David's meditation Psalm 9:15-18
 - a. The wicked nations
 - i. They will be snared in the work of their own wicked hands
 - ii. The LORD will execute His judgement on them
 - b. The righteous
 - i. The needy will ultimately not be forgotten by the LORD
 - ii. The expectation of the poor shall not perish forever
4. David's faith and trust Psalm 9:19-20
 - a. For the LORD to arise and judge
 - b. For wickedness
 - i. To not prevail
 - ii. To be judged by the LORD
 - iii. To fear the LORD and be humble before Him

ENCOURAGEMENT TO US ALL

4. God
 - a. He is a righteous Judge
 - b. He is not absent in the problems of life
5. David's example of seeking God's righteous judgement
6. Our challenge to praise and pray with confidence
 - a. In God's sovereignty
 - b. In God's timing
 - c. In God's righteous response and judgement to all that we go through
