《诗篇 11》的背景

1. 上标（诗篇的标题）

“大卫的诗，交与伶长”
2. 大卫所写的诗篇
 - a. 呈现给伶长，供敬拜之用
 - b. 大卫没有提起任何具体背景
 - c. 《诗篇 11》的主题 — 以信心回应生活中的问题

坚定投靠上帝

1. “我是投靠耶和华” 《诗篇 11：1》
 - a. 《诗篇 11》的开头和重点
 - b. 这是大卫的：
 - i. 宣言
 - ii. 决心
 - iii. 回应生活中的问题

2. 大卫选择信靠上帝的背景

a. 逃避生活中的难题之建议

“你们怎么对我说：‘你当像鸟飞往你的山去’” 《诗篇 11：1》

i. 逃避为最佳的行动

ii. 很快地逃避

b. 恶人企图毁灭他的现实

“看哪，恶人弯弓，把箭搭在弦上，要在暗中射那心里正直的人。根基若毁坏，义人还能作什么呢？” 《诗篇 11：2-3》

i. 恶人在暗中攻击

ii. 根基可以受到威胁

iii. 义人还能做什么呢？

c. 大卫的结论

i. 他不会逃避

ii. 他不会屈服于恐惧

iii. 他必在上帝里实践信心与信靠！ 《诗篇 11：1》

实践对上帝的信靠

1. 信靠上帝主宰一切 《诗篇 11：4》

a. 祂在祂的圣殿里

b. 祂的宝座在天上

c. 虽然恶人似乎很强大（弓箭），但上帝必然掌管一切
对照《诗篇 11：2-3》

2. 相信上帝看见 《诗篇 11：4》

a. 祂的慧眼看见

b. 祂察看世人

c. 恶人可能暗中射箭，但上帝看见 对照《诗篇 11：2-3》

3. 信靠上帝如何看待义人和恶人 《诗篇 11：5》

a. 祂试探义人（他们的心思和生命）

b. 祂恨恶恶人和喜爱强暴的人

4. 相信上帝会履行公义 《诗篇 11： 6》
5. 相信上帝是公义的 《诗篇 11： 7》
 - a. 祂喜爱公义
 - b. 正直人必得见祂的面
 - c. 这是大卫结尾的冥想
 - i. 不是恶人的力量
 - ii. 而是上帝的公义和正直人必得见祂的面！

对我们众人的鼓励

1. 生活中的问题可以使我们崩溃
 - a. 我们是否逃避？
 - b. 我们是否惧怕？
2. 我们可以选择该如何回应
3. 我们的挑战
 - a. 全心信靠上帝
 - b. 过正直的生活

INTRODUCTION

1. Pulpit Series – “The Davidic Psalms”
 - a. Reading selected Davidic Psalms
 - b. Understanding the context of each Psalm and what David was going through
 - c. Learning lessons about

- i. God
 - ii. Exercising faith in God
- 2. Our focus today – “In the LORD I put my trust” Psalm 11

THE CONTEXT OF PSALM 11

- 3. Superscription (Title of the Psalm)
“To the Chief Musician. A Psalm of David.”
- 4. A Psalm written by David
 - a. Presented to the Chief Musician for worship
 - b. No specific context was noted by David
 - c. The theme of Psalm 11 – responding to the problems of life with trust

A DETERMINATION TO TRUST IN THE LORD

- 1. “In the LORD I put my trust” Psalm 11:1
 - a. The opening and focus of Psalm 11
 - b. This was David’s
 - i. Declaration
 - ii. Determination
 - iii. In response to the problems of life
- 2. The context in which David chose to trust in the LORD
 - a. Advice given to flee from the problems of life
“How can you say to my soul, ‘Flee as a bird to your mountain?’”
Psalm 11:1
 - i. Fleeing as the best course of action
 - ii. To escape quickly

- b. The reality of the wicked seeking to destroy him

“For look! The wicked bend their bow, they make ready their arrow on the string, that they may shoot secretly at the upright in heart. If the foundations are destroyed, what can the righteous do?”

Psalm 11:2-3

- i. Attacks from the wicked in secret
 - ii. The very foundations can be threatened
 - iii. What can the righteous do?
- c. David’s conclusion
 - i. He will not flee
 - ii. He will not succumb to fear
 - iii. He will exercise faith and trust in the LORD! cf. Psalm 11:1

TRUST IN THE LORD EXERCISED

- 1. Trusting the LORD is Sovereign over all things Psalm 11:4
 - a. He is in His holy temple
 - b. His throne is in heaven
 - c. The wicked may seem to be strong (bow and arrow) but the LORD is in control cf. Psalm 11:2-3
- 2. Trusting that the LORD sees Psalm 11:4
 - a. His eyes behold
 - b. His eyelids test the sons of man
 - c. The wicked may shoot secretly but the LORD sees cf. Psalm 11:2-3
- 3. Trusting in how the LORD regards the righteous and wicked Psalm 11:5
 - a. He tests the righteous (their hearts and lives)
 - b. He hates the wicked and the one who loves violence

4. Trusting that the LORD will bring about justice Psalm 11:6
5. Trusting that the LORD is righteous Psalm 11:7
 - a. He loves righteousness
 - b. His countenance beholds the upright
 - c. This was David's concluding meditation
 - i. Not in the strength of the wicked
 - ii. But in the righteousness of God and God's countenance on the righteous!

1. Facing problems in life that can cause us to crumble
 - a. Do we flee?
 - b. Are we fearful?
2. The choice of response is ours to make
3. Our challenge
 - a. To wholly trust in the LORD
 - b. To live righteously
