《诗篇 12》的背景

1. 诗篇的上标（或称标题）

“大卫的诗，交与伶长。调用第八。”
2. 大卫所写的诗
 - a. 呈献给伶长，供敬拜用的
 - b. 大卫没有记载什么具体的背景
 - c. 《诗篇 12》的主题 - 对比人的言语和上帝的言语

不虔诚的人和他们的言语的问题

1. 大卫的呼求 《诗篇 12：1》
 - a. 求上帝帮助
 - b. 大卫悲惨的处境（同我们现在所处的世界）

- i. 虔诚人断绝了
- ii. 忠信人没有了
- c. 愿上帝剪除不虔诚人全部的言语 《诗篇 12: 3》

2. 不虔诚的人和他们言语的问题

- a. 他们说谎 （空话） 《诗篇 12: 2》
 - i. 在别人背后说闲话
 - ii. 很多误会和伤痛是因谎话产生的
- b. 他们说话是嘴唇油滑的 《诗篇 12: 3》
 - i. 言语说来讨好人
 - ii. 言语不一定是真的
- c. 他们说的话是心口不一的
 - i. 虚伪
 - ii. 别有用意
- d. 他们有夸大的舌头 《诗篇 12: 3-4》
 - i. 以舌头得胜
 - ii. 没有顾及任何人

上帝和祂的言语的回应

- 1. 上帝的应许 《诗篇 12: 5》
 - a. 祂会起来
 - i. 因为困苦人的冤屈
 - ii. 因为贫穷人的叹息
 - b. 祂会把他安置在他所切慕的稳妥之地

2. 沉思在上帝的言语里 《诗篇 12：6-7》

- a. 纯净的言语 （对比不虔诚人的言语）
- b. 如同银子在泥炉中炼过 （经过试探并验证）
- c. 炼过七次 （绝对纯净与完美）
- d. 上帝必遵守祂的言语
- e. 上帝会世代代保守祂的话语

3. 信靠上帝言语的重要性

- a. 我们所生活的世界的现实 《诗篇 12：8》
 - i. 恶人到处游行
 - ii. 下流人在世人中升高
- b. 但上帝纯净的言语必得胜！
- c. 认识和信靠上帝纯净的言语即是我们的挑战

给大家的鼓励

- 1. 接受我们所处在的现实
 - a. 不虔诚的人
 - b. 不敬虔的言语
- 2. 不要灰心或绝望
- 3. 下定决心要专注在上帝和祂的言语
 - a. 祂应许会为需要祂的人而起来

- b. 祂的言语
 - i. 纯净
 - ii. 验证
 - iii. 为世代而保守

 - a. Reading selected Davidic Psalms
 - b. Understanding the context of each Psalm and what David was going through

 - ii. Exercising faith in God

2. Our focus today – “The words of the LORD are pure words”

Psalm 12

THE CONTEXT OF PSALM 12

1. Superscription (Title of the Psalm)

“To the Chief Musician. On an eight-stringed harp. A Psalm of David.”

2. A Psalm written by David

- a. Presented to the Chief Musician for worship
- b. No specific context was noted by David
- c. The theme of Psalm 12 – the contrast of man’s words and God’s Word

THE PROBLEM OF UNGODLY MEN AND THEIR WORDS

1. A cry for help from David Psalm 12:1

- a. For the LORD to help
- b. The sad state of David’s situation (and also the world we live in)
 - i. The godly man ceases
 - ii. The faithful disappear
- c. For the LORD to cut off all the words of ungodly men Psalm 12:3

2. The problem of ungodly men and their words

- a. They speak idly (empty words) Psalm 12:2
 - i. Gossiping and speaking behind the back
 - ii. Much misunderstanding and hurt can arise from idle words
- b. They speak with flattering lips Psalm 12:3
 - i. Words that are said to please man
 - ii. Words that may not even be true
- c. They speak out of a double heart
 - i. Hypocrisy
 - ii. Ulterior motives

- d. They speak proud things Psalm 12:3-4
 - i. Using their words to prevail over others
 - ii. Without regard for anyone

THE RESPONSE OF THE LORD AND HIS WORD

1. The LORD's promise Psalm 12:5
 - a. He will arise
 - i. For the oppression of the poor
 - ii. For the sighing of the needy
 - b. He will set him in the safety for which he years
2. Meditating on the Word of the LORD Psalm 12:6-7
 - a. They are pure words (in contrast to the words of the ungodly)
 - b. Like silver tried in a furnace of earth (tested and proven true)
 - c. Purified seven times (absolute purity and perfection)
 - d. The LORD will keep His Word
 - e. The LORD will preserve His Word from generation to generation
3. The importance of trusting in the Word of the LORD
 - a. The reality of this world we live in Psalm 12:8
 - i. The wicked prowl on every side
 - ii. Vileness is exalted among the sons of men
 - b. But is the pure Word of the LORD that will prevail!

- c. Our challenge to know and trust in the pure Word of the LORD

ENCOURAGEMENT TO US ALL

1. To accept the reality that we live in
 - a. Ungodly men
 - b. Ungodly words
2. To not be discouraged or in despair
3. To determine to focus on the LORD and His Word
 - a. His Promise to rise up for those who need Him
 - b. His Word
 - i. Pure
 - ii. Proven
 - iii. Preserved for all generations
