《诗篇 13》的背景

1. 诗篇的上标（或称标题）

“大卫的诗，交于伶长。”
2. 大卫所写的诗
 - a. 交于伶长，用于敬拜
 - b. 大卫未注明特定的写作背景
 - c. 《诗篇 13》的主题 - 即使感觉上帝“不同在”，仍要信靠祂

感受到上帝似乎长期不同在

1. 上帝
 - a. 祂常与我们同在
 - b. 祂从未缺席
2. 然而，人或许会感到上帝仿佛“不同在”
 - a. 当困境持续不断时
 - b. 当问题迟迟未能解决时
3. 大卫内心的挣扎《诗篇 13：1-2》
 - a. “耶和华啊……要到几时呢？”
 - i. “祢忘记我……要到永远吗？”

- ii. “祢掩面不顾我要到几时呢？”
- iii. “我心里筹算，终日愁苦，要到几时呢？”

- b. 大卫内心和灵魂中的感受
 - i. 感到在挑战中，上帝似乎不与他同在
 - ii. 感到上帝似乎并不在意
 - iii. 感到上帝没有赐下任何筹算或引导
 - iv. 这使他心里终日愁苦
 - v. 又因仇敌不断凌驾于他之上而感到绝望

祈求光明

- 1. 一个祈求光明的重大祷告
 - a. 这是大卫生命的重要转折点
 - b. 他祈祷 《诗篇 13: 3-4》
 - i. 向一个最亲近的上帝 - “耶和华我的神啊！”
 - ii. 求上帝顾念并应允他
 - iii. 求上帝使他眼目光明
 - c. 光明的重要性
 - i. 能超越令人沮丧的境况
 - ii. 尽管上帝当下似乎“静默”，仍能记得上帝和祂的慈爱
 - d. 眼目不光明的危险 《诗篇 13: 3-4》
 - i. “免得我沉睡至死”（衰败而至死亡）
 - ii. “免得我的仇敌说：‘我胜了他’”（被击败）
 - iii. “免得我的敌人在我摇动的时候喜乐”（蒙羞）
- 2. 以信靠上帝的决心结束祷告
 - a. 信靠上帝的慈爱 《诗篇 13: 5》
 - i. 他过去曾信靠上帝的慈爱
 - ii. 他如今仍信靠上帝的慈爱
 - b. 心中因上帝的救恩而快乐
 - i. 一种源自信靠的特别喜乐
 - ii. 相信上帝必在祂的时候成就救恩
 - c. 向上帝歌唱（敬拜）
 - i. 因祂用厚恩待大卫

- ii. 祂也必继续如此恩待

给予我们所有人的鼓励

1. 当我们因感觉不到上帝的同在而挣扎时，转向祂祷告
2. 寻求眼目光明，得以重新认识上帝
3. 在祷告中寻求更新对上帝的信靠、喜乐和敬拜

INTRODUCTION

1. Pulpit Series – “The Davidic Psalms”
 - a. Reading selected Davidic Psalms
 - b. Understanding the context of each Psalm and what David was going through
 - c. Learning lessons about
 - i. God
 - ii. Exercising faith in God
2. Our focus today – “Enlighten my eyes” Psalm 13

THE CONTEXT OF PSALM 13

3. Superscription (Title of the Psalm)

“To the Chief Musician. A Psalm of David.”
4. A Psalm written by David
 - a. Presented to the Chief Musician for worship

- b. No specific context was noted by David
- c. The theme of Psalm 13 – trusting in God even when He feels “absent”

THE PROLONGED ABSENCE OF GOD FELT

- 4. God
 - a. He is ever present
 - b. He is never absent
- 5. However, man may feel as if God is “absent”
 - a. When problems are prolonged
 - b. When problems remain unresolved
- 6. David’s inner struggle Psalm 13:1-2
 - a. *“How long, O LORD?”*
 - i. *“Will You forget me forever?”*
 - ii. *“How long will You hide Your face from me?”*
 - iii. *“How long shall I take counsel in my soul?”*
 - b. What David felt in his heart and soul
 - i. The feeling that God was absent amidst challenges
 - ii. The feeling that God did not seem to care
 - iii. The feeling that God did not provide any counsel or guidance
 - iv. This brought about sorrow in the heart daily
 - v. There was also despair over his enemies continuing to be exalted over him

THE PRAYER FOR ENLIGHTENMENT

- 3. A most significant prayer for enlightenment

- a. This marked an important turning point for David
 - b. He prayed Psalm 13:3-4
 - i. To a most personal God – “O LORD, my God”
 - ii. For God to consider and hear
 - iii. For God to enlighten his eyes
 - c. The significance of enlightenment
 - i. Seeing beyond the distressing circumstances
 - ii. Remembering God and His mercies despite the present “silence”
 - d. The danger of not having enlightened eyes Psalm 13:3-4
 - i. *“Lest I sleep the sleep of death”* (downfall leading to death)
 - ii. *“Lest my enemy say, ‘I have prevailed against him’”* (defeat)
 - iii. *“Lest those who trouble me rejoice when I am moved”* (disgrace)
4. Concluding his prayer with a determination to trust in God
- a. To trust in God’s mercy Psalm 13:5
 - i. He had trusted in God’s mercy in the past
 - ii. He would trust in God’s mercy now
 - b. To have a heart that will rejoice in God’s salvation
 - i. A special joy that comes from trust
 - ii. Trusting that God will bring about salvation in His time
 - c. To sing to the LORD (worship)
 - i. Because He has dealt bountifully with David
 - ii. And He will surely continue to do so
