《诗篇 14》的背景

1. 诗篇的上标（或称标题）

“大卫的诗，交于伶长”
1. 大卫所写的诗
 - a. 交与伶长，用于敬拜
 - b. 大卫没有注明写作时的具体背景
 - c. 《诗篇 14》的主题 - 一首智慧诗，探讨否认上帝存在之人的愚昧

关于否认上帝存在之人的观察

1. 无神论的问题（错误的信念 / 认为没有上帝的思想）

- a. 在大卫的时代已经存在
 - b. 现今也存在
- 2. 他们的心态和信仰观 《诗篇 14： 1》
 - a. 比喻为愚顽人
 - b. 他们在内心认定说：“没有神。”
 - c. 他们相信自己无需向上帝交待
- 3. 因此产生的恶行 《诗篇 14： 1， 3-4》
 - a. 邪恶
 - b. 可憎恶的事
 - c. 似乎没有一个人行善
 - d. 他们欺压（吞吃）并羞辱他人
- 4. 然而，大卫所观察到的现实 《诗篇 14： 5》
 - a. 他们因为骄傲而不求告上帝
 - b. 但他们大大地害怕（患难来到时）

在上帝里实践信心

- 1. 上帝的存在
 - a. 不受无神论者想法的影响
 - b. 我们对上帝的信心教导我们如何正确地回应
 - i. 对于无神论者的心态和信仰观
 - ii. 对于无神论者的恶行
- 2. 大卫信心的表现

- a. 上帝从天上垂看世人 《诗篇 14： 2》
 - i. 要看有谁明白祂
 - ii. 要看有谁寻求祂
- b. 上帝保守信靠祂的义人 《诗篇 14： 5-6》
 - i. 上帝在义人的族类中
 - ii. 上帝是困苦人的避难所
- c. 在上帝里得着盼望
 - i. 上帝必赐救恩
 - ii. 上帝必拯救祂的子民
- d. 在上帝里快乐，欢喜
 - i. 雅各（尽管我们软弱且犯罪）
 - ii. 以色列（确信我们是属上帝立约的子民）

给予大家的鼓励

- 1. 应当认识到
 - a. 有些人否认上帝的存在
 - b. 有些人活在不义之中
- 2. 要做出正确回应
 - a. 不灰心
 - b. 不愤怒
 - c. 乃是凭着信心
- 3. 在世上实践信心

- a. 在上帝里
- b. 在上帝所赐的救恩中
- c. 在上帝里所得着的喜乐

1. Pulpit Series – “The Davidic Psalms”
 - a. Reading selected Davidic Psalms
 - b. Understanding the context of each Psalm and what David was going through
 - c. Learning lessons about
 - i. God
 - ii. Exercising faith in God
2. Our focus today – “Let Jacob rejoice and Israel be glad” Psalm 14

THE CONTEXT OF PSALM 14

1. Superscription (Title of the Psalm)

“To the Chief Musician. A Psalm of David.”
2. A Psalm written by David
 - a. Presented to the Chief Musician for worship
 - b. No specific context was noted by David

- c. The theme of Psalm 14 – a wisdom Psalm concerning the foolish that deny God's existence

OBSERVATIONS CONCERNING THOSE WHO DENY GOD'S EXISTENCE

1. The problem of atheism (the wrong belief / ideology that there is no God)
 - a. It existed during the time of David
 - b. It exists today
2. Their mindset and belief system Psalm 14:1
 - a. Likened to a fool
 - b. They say in their hearts, "There is no God"
 - c. They believe that there is no God to be accountable to
3. Thus their wicked behavior Psalm 14:1, 3-4
 - a. Corrupt
 - b. Abominable works
 - c. It almost seems that there is none who does good
 - d. They oppress (eat up) and shame others
4. Yet the reality David observed Psalm 14:5
 - a. They do not call on the LORD in their pride
 - b. But they are in great fear (when troubles come)

FAITH EXERCISED IN GOD

1. God's existence
 - a. Is not affected by what the atheists think
 - b. Our faith in God teaches us to respond correctly

- i. To the mindset / belief system of the atheists
 - ii. To the wicked behavior of the atheists
- 2. David's faith expressed
 - a. That God looks down from heaven Psalm 14:2
 - i. To see who understands Him
 - ii. To see who seeks Him
 - b. That God protects the righteous believer Psalm 14:5-6
 - i. God is with the generation of the righteous
 - ii. God is the refuge of the poor
 - c. Hope in God
 - i. God will grant salvation
 - ii. God will deliver His people
 - d. Rejoicing and being glad in God
 - i. Jacob (despite us being weak and sinful)
 - ii. Israel (assured that we are God's covenant people)

ENCOURAGEMENT TO US ALL

- 1. To recognize
 - a. That there are those who reject God's existence
 - b. That there are those who live unrighteous
- 2. To respond correctly
 - a. Not in despair

- b. Not in anger
 - c. But in faith
- 3. Exercising faith as we live in this world
 - a. In God
 - b. In the salvation that He gives
 - c. In the joy that we can find in Him
