## 《诗篇 15》的背景

### 1. 诗篇的上标（或称标题）

" 大卫的诗 "

### 2. 大卫所写的诗

- a. 大卫没有特别注明这诗的具体背景
- b. 《诗篇 15》的主题 - 正义的人

## 重温《诗篇 14》

### 1. 哀叹愚顽的人 《诗篇 14：1》

- a. 他们心里说： " 没有神。 "
- b. 他们都是邪恶的
- c. 没有一个人行善

### 2. 上帝 《诗篇 14：2》

- a. 祂从天上垂看世人
- b. 要看有明白的没有，有寻求上帝的没有

## 问题是谁才能寄居在上帝面前

### 1. " 耶和华啊！谁能寄居祢的帐幕？谁能住在祢的圣山？ " 《诗篇 15：1》

- a. 在上帝面前

- i. 被形容为 " 祂的帐幕 "
    - ii. 被形容为 " 祂的圣山 "
  - b. 提出必要的问题
    - i. 世上有很多人否定上帝的存在 《诗篇 14》
    - ii 那么谁才可以亲近上帝呢？
    - iii. 那么谁才可以寄居与住在上帝面前？

## 2. 提出这个问题的重要性

- a. 亲近上帝及住在祂面前，绝不能被视为理所当然
- b. 上帝不会允许任何人随意来到祂面前

## 对义人的描述

### 1. 回答大卫开场时的问題

- a. 可在《诗篇 15：2-5》中找到
- b. 只有义人才能亲近上帝，寄住在祂的面前

### 2. 对义人美好的描述

- a. 他为人处事正直 《诗篇 15：2》
  - i. 他行为（生活）正直
  - ii 他做事公义
  - iii. 他心里说实话
- b. 他待人接物都正直公义 《诗篇 15：3-4》
  - i. 他不以舌头谗谤人（不在背后说人坏话）
  - ii. 他不恶待朋友
  - iii. 他不随伙毁谤邻里（参与针对他人的负面报告）
  - iv. 他 " 藐视 " 匪类（这意味着他拒绝邪恶）
  - v. 他尊重那敬畏上帝的人
- c. 在处理财富和财产方面秉持正义 《诗篇 15：4-5》
  - i. 他信守承诺，即使这会让他吃亏（财务损失）
  - ii. 他放贷不是为了剥削他人，而是为了帮助他人
  - iii. 他不受贿赂以歪曲正义

- a. 一个绝赞的荣幸
- b. 一个最美妙的赐福

  - a. 在生活中
  - b. 在家庭里
  - c. 在事工里
  - d. 在晚年时

### **INTRODUCTION**

1. Pulpit Series – “The Davidic Psalms”
  - a. Reading selected Davidic Psalms
  - b. Understanding the context of each Psalm and what David was going through
  - c. Learning lessons about
    - i. God
    - ii. Exercising faith in God
2. Our focus today – “LORD, who may abide in Your tabernacle?” Psalm 15

### **THE CONTEXT OF PSALM 15**

1. Superscription (Title of the Psalm)

*“A Psalm of David.”*
2. A Psalm written by David
  - a. No specific context was noted by David
  - b. The theme of Psalm 15 – the righteous man

## **REVIEWING PSALM 14**

1. A lament concerning the fool Psalm 14:1
  - a. Who says in his heart “there is no God”
  - b. They are corrupt
  - c. None do good
2. The LORD Psalm 14:2
  - a. He looks down from heaven
  - b. To see if there are any who understand, who seek God

## **THE QUESTION WHO MAY ABIDE IN GOD’S PRESENCE**

1. “Lord, who may abide in Your tabernacle? Who may dwell in Your holy hill?”  
Psalm 15:1
  - a. The presence of God
    - i. Described as “His tabernacle”
    - ii. Described as “His holy hill”
  - b. The essential question raised
    - i. There are many in the world who denounce God Psalm 14
    - ii. Who then may draw near to God?
    - iii. Who then may abide and dwell in His Presence
2. The significance of raising this question
  - a. To draw near and abide in God’s Presence must never be taken for granted
  - b. God would not allow simply anyone to come into His Presence

## **A DESCRIPTION OF THE RIGHTEOUS MAN**

1. The answer to David’s opening question
  - a. Found from Psalm 15:2-5
  - b. It is the righteous man who may draw near to and abide in God’s Presence

## 2. A wonderful description of the righteous man

### a. Righteous in the way he lives

Psalm 15:2

- i. He walks (lives) uprightly
- ii. He works righteousness
- iii. He speaks the truth in his heart

### b. Righteous in how he relates to others

Psalm 15:3-4

- i. He does not backbite with his tongue (speak behind someone's back)
- ii. He does not do evil to his neighbor
- iii. He does not take up a reproach against his neighbor (participate in negative report against others)
- iv. He "despises" the vile person (meaning: he rejects wickedness)
- v. He honors those who fear the LORD

### c. Righteous in how he handles wealth and possessions

Psalm 15:4-5

- i. He keeps his promises even if it hurts (costs) him
- ii. He does not lend in order to exploit others but to help
- iii. He does not take a bribe to pervert justice

## **GOD'S BLESSINGS ON THE RIGHTEOUS MAN**

### 1. Drawing close to God and abiding with Him

Psalm 15:1

- a. An awesome privilege
- b. A most wondrous blessing

### 2. Stability amidst the challenges of the world

Psalm 15:5

- a. In life
- b. In family
- c. In ministry

d. In old age
