《诗篇 16》的背景

1. 诗篇的上标（或称标题）
“*大卫的金诗。*”
2. “金诗”的意思
 - a. 一个从希伯来文音译而来的词语
 - b. 可能的含义：
 - i. “铭刻的” — 意指值得保存和纪念
 - ii. “黄金的” — 珍贵且极有价值
 - c. 《诗篇 16》的主题 — 上帝为我们最宝贵的产业

大卫表达了对上帝的信心与信靠

1. 个人对上帝的投靠与依赖 《诗篇 16：1-2》
 - a. 投靠那位保佑人的上帝
 - b. 认识上帝是万有的主宰
 - c. 珍惜上帝是一切好处的源头
2. 在上帝里面得着满足 《诗篇 16：3-6》
 - a. 上帝是大卫的产业和他杯中的份
 - i. 大卫生命中最大的福分（不是物质财富，而是上帝）

- ii. 大卫满足与供应的源头
- b. 上帝是那位持守他所得的主
 - i. 为上帝向他所行的一切事献上感恩
 - ii. 视上帝所赐给和分配的一切为佳美和美好的
- 3. 亲身蒙上帝指教与警戒 《诗篇 16： 7-8》
 - a. 上帝所赐的指教
 - b. 上帝不断警戒大卫的心肠
 - c. 即使在夜间（黑暗和艰难的时期）
 - d. 大卫不得不称颂上帝
- 4. 对上帝的盼望 《诗篇 16： 9-11》
 - a. 救恩
 - i. 上帝不会将大卫的灵魂撇在阴间
 - ii. 上帝不会容许大卫永远停留在死亡之中
 - b. 弥赛亚预言
 - i. “圣者”最终应验在主耶稣基督里
 - ii. 主耶稣基督不会见朽坏（祂将从死里复活）参《使徒行传 2： 25-28》
 - c. 永生
 - i. 上帝必指示他生命的道路
 - ii. 上帝的同在将带来永远满足的喜乐

大卫对上帝的信心与投靠所产生的影响

- 1. 祷告与投靠 《诗篇 16； 1》
- 2. 对待他人 《诗篇 16： 3-4》
 - a. 对上帝的圣民
 - i. 视他们为又美又善
 - ii. 为他们而喜悦
- 3. 决心称颂上帝 《诗篇 16： 7》
- 4. 在上帝里的信心 《诗篇 16： 8》
 - a. 将上帝常摆在自己面前
 - b. 因着上帝而不致摇动

5. 因上帝而欢喜快乐 《诗篇 16：9》

6. 在上帝里存盼望 《诗篇 16：9》

- a. Reading selected Davidic Psalms

2. Our focus today – “O Lord, You are the portion of my inheritance and my cup”
Psalm 16

THE CONTEXT OF PSALM 16

1. Superscription (Title of the Psalm)

“A Michtam of David.”

2. Meaning of “Michtam”

- a. A transliterated word from Hebrew
- b. Possible meanings
 - i. “Engraved” – meant to be preserved
 - ii. “Golden” – precious and of great value
- c. The theme of Psalm 16 – God as our greatest inheritance

DAVID’S FAITH AND TRUST IN GOD EXPRESSED

- 1. Personal trust and dependence Psalm 16:1-2
 - a. Trusting in God who preserves
 - b. Recognizing God as Lord over all things
 - c. Appreciating God as the Source of all that is good in life
- 2. Personal satisfaction in God Psalm 16:3-6
 - a. God as the portion of David’s inheritance and his cup
 - i. David’s greatest blessing in life (not physical possession but God Himself)
 - ii. David’s source of satisfaction and sustenance
 - b. God as One who maintains his lot
 - i. Thanksgiving and gratitude for all that God has done for him
 - ii. Seeing what God has given and allotted as pleasant and good
- 3. Personally instructed and guided by God Psalm 16:7-8
 - a. Counsel given by God
 - b. God continues to instruct David’s heart
 - c. Even in the night seasons (periods of darkness and difficulty)

- d. David cannot but bless the LORD
- 4. Hope in God Psalm 16:9-11
 - a. Salvation
 - i. God will not leave David's soul in Sheol
 - ii. He will now allow David to remain in a state of death
 - b. A Messianic reference
 - i. "The Holy One" fulfilled in the Lord Jesus Christ
 - ii. The Lord Jesus Christ not see corruption (He will be raised from the dead) cf. Acts 2:25-28
 - c. Everlasting life
 - i. God will show him the path of life
 - ii. God's Presence will bring fullness of joy forevermore

- 1. Prayer and trust Psalm 16:1
- 2. Regard for others Psalm 16:3-4
 - a. The saints of God
 - i. Regarding them as the excellent ones
 - ii. Delighting in them
- 3. Determination to bless the LORD Psalm 16:7
- 4. Confidence in God Psalm 16:8
 - a. Setting the LORD always before him
 - b. Standing firm always because of God
- 5. Rejoicing in God Psalm 16:9
- 6. Hope in God Psalm 16:9
