 - a) Humble attitude
 - i) They submitted to the other leaders (Acts 13:2)
 - ii) They relied on the grace of God (Acts 14:26)

b) Persevering attitude

- i) Paul persevered despite facing constant opposition and suffering (Acts 14:19)
- ii) John Mark did not press on (Acts 13:13)
