 - a) Public Worship
 - b) Prayers were formally uttered
- 2. The Public Ministry of Praise
 - a) A Temple musician
 - b) Supportive role
- 3. The Public Ministry of Prophecy
 - a) As and when God gives a prophetic word
 - b) Not a fixed role

GLIMPSES OF THE PERSONAL PRAYER LIFE OF ASAPH

1. Recalling a time when God heard and answered Prayers (Psalm 77:1)

"I cried out to God with my voice to God with my voice; and He gave ear to me" Psalm 77:1

- a) A happy memory
- b) A wonderful experience

- 2. Remembering a time when God did not seem to hear his prayers
 - a) Seeking God

"In the day of my trouble I sought the LORD;" Psalm 77:2a

b) Outstretched hand

"My hand was stretched out in the night without ceasing" Psalm 77:2b

c) Soul searching

"My soul refused to be comforted" Psalm 77:2c

d) Remembering God

"I remembered God, and was troubled" Psalm 77:3a

e) A complaining spirit

"I complained, and my spirit was overwhelmed" Psalm 77:3b

f) Troubled

"I am so troubled that I cannot speak" Psalm 77:4b

g) Anguish

"This is my anguish" Psalm 77:10a

FINDING THE WAY OUT OF A SPIRITUAL DILEMMA

- 1. Recalling Biblical history
 - a) "I have considered the days of old" (Psalm 77:5a)
 - b) "The years of ancient times" (Psalm 77:5b)
- 2. Recalling a song in the night
 - a) A special song remembered

"I call to remembrance my song in the night" Psalm 77:6a

- b) This song brought a measure of comfort
- 3. The Practice of Meditation
 - a) Meditation of the heart

"I meditate within my heart" Psalm 77:6b

b) Search of the spirit

"And my spirit makes diligent search" Psalm 77:6c

c) Remembering the right hand of God

"But I will remember the years of the right hand of the Most High" Psalm 77:10b

d) Remembering God's works

"I will remember the works of the LORD, Surely I will remember Your wonders of old" Psalm 77:11

e) Meditation on God's work

"I will also meditate on all Your work And talk of Your deeds" Psalm 77:12

THE GREATNESS OF GOD REDISCOVERED

1. The way of God

"Your way, O God, is in the sanctuary; Who is so great a God as our God?" Psalm 77:13

2. The wonders of God

"You are the God who does wonders; You have declared Your strength among the peoples" Psalm 77:14

3. The redemptive work of God

"You have with Your arm redeemed Your people; The sons of Jacob and Joseph" Psalm 77:15
