<ol> <li>Trust in the LORD, and do good;</li> <li>Dwell in the land, and feed on His faithfulness.</li> </ol>	(Psalm 37:3)
2. Delight yourself also in the LORD,	

And He shall give you the desires of your heart. (Psalm 37:4)

3. Commit your way to the LORD,
Trust also in Him,
And He shall bring *it* to pass. (Psalm 37:5)

4. He shall bring forth your righteousness as the light, And your justice as the noonday. (Psalm 37:6)

5. Rest in the LORD, and wait patiently for Him; (Psalm 37:7)

(Psalm 37:24) 13. For the LORD loves justice, And does not forsake His saints; They are preserved forever, But the descendants of the wicked shall be cut off. (Psalm 37:28) 14. The law of his God is in his heart; None of his steps shall slide. (Psalm 37:31) 15. The LORD will not leave him in his hand, Nor condemn him when he is judged. (Psalm 37:33) 16. Wait on the LORD, And keep His way, And He shall exalt you to inherit the land; When the wicked are cut off, you shall see it. (Psalm 37:34) 17. But the salvation of the righteous is from the LORD; *He is* their strength in the time of trouble. (Psalm 37:39) 18. And the LORD shall help them and deliver them; He shall deliver them from the wicked. And save them, Because they trust in Him. (Psalm 37:40)

The Lord laughs at him, For He sees that his day is coming	(Psalm 37:13)
c) He breaks the power of the wicked	
For the arms of the wicked shall be broken	(Psalm 37:17)
d) He will cause the wicked to perish	
But the wicked shall perish	(Psalm 37: 20)
2. The Road of the Wicked	
a) A hard road	
b) Resisted by the Lord	
c) Wickedness must be abandoned	
THE LORD AND THE UPRIGHT	
God will provide for the Upright	
a) And He shall give you the desires of your heart	(Psalm 37:4)
b) They shall inherit the earth	(Psalm 37:9)
2. God will protect the Righteous	
a) But the LORD upholds the righteous.	(Psalm 37:17, 24)
<ul><li>b) And does not forsake His saints;</li><li>They are preserved forever</li></ul>	(Psalm 37:28)

c) The LORD will not leave him in his hand,
Nor condemn him when he is judged (Psalm 37:33)

d) And the LORD shall help them and deliver them;
He shall deliver them from the wicked,
And save them,
Because they trust in Him. (Psalm 37:40)
