<sup>9</sup> For evildoers shall be cut off; But those who wait on the LORD, They shall inherit the earth.

<sup>10</sup> For yet a little while and the wicked shall be no more; Indeed, you will look carefully for his place, But it shall be no more.

- <sup>11</sup> But the meek shall inherit the earth, And shall delight themselves in the abundance of peace. Psalm 37:9-11
- 1. The Evildoers/ The Wicked
  - a) They think that they will inherit the earth
  - b) They have "the means"
    - i) The wealth
    - ii) The power
    - iii) The wherewithal to purchase property

c) But the reality is quite different

i) They are "cut off" (Psalm 37:9a)

ii) They will be "no more" (Psalm 37:10a)

iii) Life is in the power of God!

a) They wait on the LORD (Psalm 37:9b)

b) They delight in the abundance of peace

c) They shall inherit the earth (Psalm 37:9c, 11a)

# **UPHOLDING OF THE RIGHTEOUS**

<sup>12</sup> The wicked plots against the just, And gnashes at him with his teeth.

<sup>13</sup> The Lord laughs at him, For He sees that his day is coming.

<sup>14</sup> The wicked have drawn the sword And have bent their bow, To cast down the poor and needy, To slay those who are of upright conduct.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>15</sup> Their sword shall enter their own heart, And their bows shall be broken.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>16</sup> A little that a righteous man has Is better than the riches of many wicked.
