#### THE COMMENCMENT OF THE PUBLIC MINISTRY OF THE LORD JESUS

1. Noted by the Gospel writers: Matthew

<sup>12</sup> Now when Jesus heard that John had been put in prison, He departed to Galilee. <sup>13</sup> And leaving Nazareth, He came and dwelt in Capernaum, which is by the sea, in the regions of Zebulun and Naphtali, <sup>14</sup> that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying:

<sup>15</sup> "The land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali,

By the way of the sea, beyond the Jordan,

Galilee of the Gentiles:

<sup>16</sup> The people who sat in darkness have seen a great light, And upon those who sat in the region and shadow of death Light has dawned." <sup>17</sup> From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand." Matthew 4:12-17

- a) The Problem stated candidly
  - i) Sitting in darkness
  - ii) In the region and shadow of death
- b) The Solution offered
  - i) Great Light
  - ii) The Kingdom of heaven is at hand

### 2. Noted by the Gospel writers: Mark

<sup>14</sup> Now after John was put in prison, Jesus came to Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God, <sup>15</sup> and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel." Mark 1:14-15

a) Preaching the gospel

"Preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God" Mark 1:14

b) Time

"The time is fulfilled" Mark 1:15a

c) At hand

"The Kingdom of God is at hand" Mark 1:15b

d) Believe

"Believe in the gospel" Mark 1:15c

## 3. Noted by the Gospel writers: Luke

- a) The crowd tried to keep the Lord from leaving them
- b) His answer:
  - i) Preaching the kingdom of God

"I must preach the kingdom of God to the other cities also" Luke 4:43a

ii) Purpose of God

"Because for this purpose I have been sent" Luke 4:43b

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>42</sup> Now when it was day, He departed and went into a deserted place. And the crowd sought Him and came to Him, and tried to keep Him from leaving them; <sup>43</sup> but He said to them, "I must preach the kingdom of God to the other cities also, because for this purpose I have been sent." <sup>44</sup> And He was preaching in the synagogues of Galilee. Luke 4:42-44

## THE PREACHING OF THE GOSPEL WITH POWER

<sup>23</sup> And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people. <sup>24</sup> Then His fame went throughout all Syria; and they brought to Him all sick people who were afflicted with various diseases and torments, and those who were demon-possessed, epileptics, and paralytics; and He healed them. <sup>25</sup> Great multitudes followed Him—from Galilee, and from Decapolis, Jerusalem, Judea, and beyond the Jordan. Matthew 4:23-25

- 2. With divine power
  - a) Healing all kinds of sicknesses
  - b) All kinds of diseases
  - c) Healing all who were demon-possessed (Matthew 4:23-24)
