 - d) But they faced a huge problem: A lack of Love

ONE OF THE CONFLICTS IN THE CHURCH

- 1. There was divided opinions concerning the Gift of Tongues
- 2. The Church was soon engulfed by this problem
- 3. It had to be resolved firmly

GETTING THE DOCTRINE OF TONGUES RIGHT

- 1. A clear and correct understanding of the Gift of Tongues
 - a) This must be understood carefully
 - b) It must be comprehended fully
- 2. A clear and correct application of the Gift of Tongues
 - a) Truth is of vital importance
 - b) The application of the truth in the church is just as important

²⁷ Now you are the body of Christ, and members individually.

²⁸ And God has appointed these in the church: first apostles, second prophets, third teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, administrations, varieties of tongues.

²⁹ Are all apostles? Are all prophets? Are all teachers? Are all workers of miracles?

³⁰ Do all have gifts of healings? Do all speak with tongues? Do all interpret?

³¹ But earnestly desire the [[]best gifts. And yet I show you a more excellent way.

¹Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I have become sounding brass or a clanging cymbal.

² And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing.

³ And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, but have not love, it profits me nothing.

⁴ Love suffers long and is kind; love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up;

⁵ does not behave rudely, does not seek its own, is not provoked, ^[2]thinks no evil;

⁶ does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth;

⁷ bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

⁸ Love never fails. But whether there are prophecies, they will fail; whether there are tongues, they will cease; whether there is knowledge, it will vanish away.
