*<sup>27</sup> These all wait for You,  
That You may give them their food in due season.*

*<sup>28</sup> What You give them they gather in;  
You open Your hand, they are filled with good.*

*<sup>29</sup> You hide Your face, they are troubled;  
You take away their breath, they die and return to their dust.*

*<sup>30</sup> You send forth Your Spirit, they are created;  
And You renew the face of the earth.*

*Psalm 104:27-30*

1. All creatures wait on the Lord for their provisions
2. God faithfully gives them their food in due season
3. God's vital role
  - a) He gives life
  - b) He also sustains life
  - c) If God hides His face, all are troubled
  - d) If He takes away their breath, they will die
  - e) He sends forth His Spirit to create life
