b) God used this title "LORD"

i) As the covenantal name Israel may use to address Him Exodus 6:3

ii) As the LORD who redeems His people from Egypt Exodus 6:6

iii) As the LORD who gives Canaan as the Promised Land Exodus 6:4, 8

iv) As the LORD God to His people Exodus 6:7
