THE LIGHT PROMISED BY THE LORD

- 1. Prophecy proclaimed

 - i) God will give a great Light
 - ii) This Light will shine amidst the darkness (Isaiah 9:2)
- 2. Prophecy fulfilled
 - a) The Messiah will be born
 - b) He will be given to His people (Isaiah 9:6)
 - c) He will have the greatest, most glorious name (Isaiah 9:6)
 - d) Jesus literally fulfilled this prophetic word (Matthew 4:14-16)
