1. Problems in life

3. Known ways of enemies of life
 - a) They seek to overwhelm and triumph over others (Psalm 25:2)
 - b) They deal treacherously without cause (Psalm 25:3)

SEEKING GOD IN THE COMPLEXITIES OF LIFE

1. Lifting up of the soul to God (Psalm 25:1)
2. Trusting in God (Psalm 25:2a)

3. Praying to God

- a) Let me not be ashamed (Psalm 25:2b)
- b) Let not my enemies triumph over me (Psalm 25:2c)
- c) Let the enemies be ashamed instead (Psalm 25:3b)

SEEKING GOD MORE SPECIFICALLY

1. Show me Your ways, O LORD (Psalm 25:4a)

- a) To show His ways
- b) To enlighten

2. Teach me Your paths (Psalm 25:4b)

- a) To teach
- b) To make very clear

3. Lead me in Your truth and teach me (Psalm 25:5a)

- a) To take the lead
- b) To teach and to confirm
