3. Turn Yourself to me, and have mercy on me (Psalm 25:16a)

1. For goodness' sake (not man's!) (Psalm 25:7c)

*"Good and upright is the LORD
Therefore He teaches sinners in the way" Psalm 25:8b*

2. For Your name's sake (Psalm 25:11a)

*"For the LORD will not forsake His people, for His great name's sake
because it pleased the LORD to make you His People" 1 Samuel 12:22*
