Numbers 12:6-8

- a) The example of Moses
- b) God spoke to him “face to face”
 - i) Plainly
 - ii) Not in dark sayings
 - iii) He sees the form of the LORD

- b) Faithful in all My house

Psalm 24:6

1. Knowledge of the need to seek God's Face

- a) This is Jacob
- b) The generation of those who seek God
- c) They seek His face

2. Reiteration and Response of the challenge to seek God's Face

- a) When You said, "Seek My face"
- b) My heart said to You

"Your face, LORD, I will seek" Psalm 27:8

2. God's Power promised

- b) Strength (Psalm 89:20)
- c) Established (Psalm 89:20)
- d) Horn exalted (Psalm 89:24)

FEAR OF GOD HIDING HIS FACE

1. Do not hide Your face from me (Psalm 27:9a)
2. Do not turn away Your servant away in anger (Psalm 27:9b)
3. Do not leave me or forsake Me (Psalm 27:9c)
