**Text: Numbers 17** 

### THE PROBLEM OF A COMPLAINING SPIRIT

- 1. It had plagued Israel incessantly
- 2. God wanted to put a stop to this problem

"I will rid Myself of the complaints of the children of Israel, which they made against you" Numbers 17:5

- a) God was concerned His servant Moses
- b) He was grieved and angry with the constant complaining spirit of Israel

### THE RODS OF THE LEADERS OF ISRAEL

- 1. Each rod will bear the name of the leader of the tribe
- 2. Each rod will be submitted by the individual tribe
- 3. The leaders gave to Moses the rods (Numbers 17:5)
- 4. The rod of Aaron was among the rods (Numbers 17:6)
- 5. The rods were placed in the Tabernacle of witness (Numbers 17:7)

### THE SIGN

- 1. God will cause the chosen rod to blossom (Numbers 17:5)
- 2. This would be a clear and obvious miracle

## THE ROD OF AARON

- 1. The rods were returned the next day
- 2. The rod of Aaron
  - a) It blossomed
  - b) It sprouted and brought forth buds
  - c) It yielded ripe almonds (Numbers 17:8)

- 3. The rod of Aaron would be kept in the Tabernacle
  - a) It would be a sign against the rebels
  - b) Complaints must be stopped
  - c) The penalty is death

(Numbers 17:10)

"Surely we die, we perish, we all perish!" Numbers 17: 12

"Whoever even comes near to the tabernacle of the Lord must die. Shall we all utterly die?" Numbers 17:13
