1. They will not enter the Land of Canaan
2. They will move back to the Wilderness (Numbers 14:25)
3. The complainers
 - a) 20 years old and above
 - b) They will wander and die in the wilderness (Numbers 14:26-29, 32)
4. Caleb and Joshua will enter into the Promised Land (Numbers 14:30)
5. The Children ("The little ones") (Numbers 14:31-33)
 - a) God will bring them into the land
 - b) He would help them dwell in the land
 - c) They will be shepherds in the wilderness
 - d) They will bear the brunt of their parents' unfaithfulness
6. Wilderness sojourn (Numbers 14:34)
 - a) Forty years
 - b) Forty days of spying the land (one year for each day spent)
7. Judgment explained
 - a) You shall know My rejection (Numbers 14:34)
 - b) Evil congregation (Numbers 14:34)
 - i) Gathered against the Lord
 - ii) Despising of the land
 - iii) Unbelief
 - iv) Rebellion

8. The 10 spies

- a) Gave a bad report
- b) It was a false report
- c) Made the congregation complain
- d) They died by the plague
