TRIUMPHAL ENTRY

1. The city gates of ancient cities

- a) Lift up your heads, O you gates (Psalm 24:7a)
- b) Be lifted up, you everlasting doors (Psalm 24:7b)

2. The King of glory shall come in Psalm 24:7c

- a) In triumph
- b) Having been victorious

3. Messianic significance

- a) The Lord Jesus Christ would enter into Jerusalem triumphantly
- b) Prophetic glimpse of the Triumphal Entry of Christ
 - i) Matthew 21:1-11
Sadly poorly understood by the multitudes
 - ii) Revelation 19:11-16
