3. Do not leave me nor forsake me (Psalm 27:9c)

TRUST IN GOD

1. Earthly parents

They may forsake (Psalm 27:10a)

2. God will take care of us (Psalm 27:10b)

PRAYING TO GOD TO TEACH

1. Teach me Your way, O LORD (Psalm 27:11a)

2. Lead me in a smooth path (Psalm 27:11b)

CONSCIOUSNESS OF ENEMIES

1. Presence and reality of enemies (Psalm 27:11-12)

a) False witnesses

b) Violence feared

2. Fear felt

a) I would have lost heart (Psalm 27:13a)

b) Fear of losing life (Psalm 27:13b)

1. Unless I had believed (Psalm 27:13a)

2. That I would see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living (Psalm 27:13b)

3. Waiting on the Lord (Psalm 27:14a)
