 - ii) They will try and destroy it

i) Is in the law of the LORD

ii) In His law he meditates day and night

THE BLESSING OF THE RIGHTEOUS PERSON

1. He will be blessed by the Lord Psalm 1:1

2. Compared to a tree Psalm 1:3

a) Planted by the rivers of water

b) That brings forth its fruit in its season

c) Whose leaf also shall not wither

d) And whatever he does shall prosper

e) The Lord knows the way of the righteous Psalm 1:6a

THE UNGODLY IN CONTRAST

1. The ungodly are like chaff which the wind drives away Psalm 1:4

2. The ungodly shall not stand in the judgment Psalm 1:5

3. The sinners will not stand in the congregation of the righteous Psalm 1:5

4. The way of the ungodly shall perish Psalm 1:6b
