- b) Even in the heavens
- c) This must be established personally

Psalm 119:90-91

- a) It endures to all generations
- b) Demonstrated by how the Lord sustains the earth

## **3. The word of God amidst Afflictions**

Unless Your law *had been* my delight,  
I would then have perished in my affliction.

Psalm 119:92

- a) The law of God as our Delight
- b) It is a key factor that saves us when we suffer affliction
