- 2. This is an explanation of his ministry to the Gentiles

THE WORKS OF THE APOSTLE PAUL

¹⁸ For I will not dare to speak of any of those things which Christ has not accomplished through me, in word and deed, to make the Gentiles obedient—

¹⁹ in mighty signs and wonders, by the power of the Spirit of God, so that from Jerusalem and round about to Illyricum I have fully preached the gospel of Christ.

Romans 15:18-19

- 1. The deeds of Paul They were described as "accomplishments"
- 2. They were both "in word and deed"
- 3. The ministry "in word"

¹⁸ For I will not dare to speak of any of those things which Christ has not accomplished through me, in word and deed, to make the Gentiles obedient—

¹⁹ in mighty signs and wonders, by the power of the Spirit of God, so that from Jerusalem and round about to Illyricum I have fully preached the gospel of Christ.

²⁰ And so I have made it my aim to preach the gospel, not where Christ was named, lest I should build on another man's foundation,

²¹ but as it is written:

- c) Establishing of churches

5. Accompanying confirmatory works

- a) Signs and wonders
- b) By the power of the Holy Spirit

1. To help Gentile believers

- a) To come to faith
- b) To become obedient

2. The work

- a) It was not just preaching the Gospel
- b) It included the work of discipling the Gentile believers

3. The Great Commission fulfilled

¹⁸ And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.

¹⁹ Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

²⁰ teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.
