⁹ Greet Urbanus, our fellow worker in Christ, and Stachys, my beloved.

¹⁰ Greet Apelles, approved in Christ. Greet those who are of the household of Aristobulus.

¹¹ Greet Herodion, my countryman. Greet those who are of the household of Narcissus who are in the Lord.

¹² Greet Tryphena and Tryphosa, who have laboured in the Lord. Greet the beloved Persis, who laboured much in the Lord.

¹³ Greet Rufus, chosen in the Lord, and his mother and mine.

¹⁴ Greet Asyncritus, Phlegon, Hermas, Patrobas, Hermes, and the brethren who are with them.

¹⁵ Greet Philologus and Julia, Nereus and his sister, and Olympas, and all the saints who are with them.

¹⁶ Greet one another with a holy kiss. The churches of Christ greet you.

c) Stachys

"My beloved" Romans 16:9b

d) Apelles

"Approved in Christ" Romans 16:10a

e) Aristobulus

He had a household (family) Romans 16:10b

f) Herodion

"My countryman" Romans 16:11a

g) Narcissus

"Household... who are in Christ" Romans 16:11b

h) Tryphena and Tryphosa

"Laboured in the Lord" Romans 16:12a

i) Persis

"Beloved... laboured much in the Lord" Romans 16:12b

j) Rufus

"Chosen in the Lord,

and his mother and mine" Romans 16:13

2. A continued list of friends with greetings sent to them (Groups of friends)

a) Asyncritus, Phlegon, Hermas, Patrobas, Hermes

And the brethren who are with them Romans 16:14

b) Philologus and Julia, Nereus and his sister Romans 16:15a

c) And Olympas, and all the saints who are with them Romans 16:15b

- 1. Some may be called "Individual friends"
- 2. Some friends were grouped together
 - a) A natural cluster
 - b) This is not necessary a clique

- 3. A collection of churches
 - a) Paul founded many churches
 - b) They were close to Paul
 - c) There was a collection of them

- 2. But all of them were close to the Apostle Paul
- 3. He had maintained a special relationship with them
