ii) "As God commanded him" Genesis 7:16

iii) "So Noah went out..." Genesis 8:18a

b) The worship of the Lord

i) "He built an altar to the LORD" Genesis 8:20a

ii) "And took of every clean animal" Genesis 8:20b

iii) "And of every clean bird" Genesis 8:20c

- iv) "And offered burnt offerings on the altar" Genesis 8:20d
- 3. An Appreciation of the Personal Worship of Noah
 - a) This was Planned worship
 - b) Proper offering of clean animals/birds
 - c) Personal gratitude to God

 - ii) "Nor will I again destroy every living thing as I have done"

 - c) A glorious promise II
 - i) While the earth remains
 - ii) Seedtime and harvest,Cold and heat,Winter and summerAnd day and nightShall not cease"
