"MOAB WAS EXCEEDINGLY AFRAID" NUMBERS 22:3 Text: Numbers 22:1-21

THE DREAD THAT WAS KEENLY FELT BY THE MOABITES NUMBERS 22:1-4

- 1. The people of Israel had camped in the plains of Moab
- 2. They had been victorious against King Sihon and King Og
- 3. The dread was deeply felt by the Moabites as they heard of these great defeats
- 4. This fear was prophesied earlier
 - a. Fear and dread would fall on them Exodus 15:14-16
 - b. The Lord would send His dread before them Exodus 23:27
- 5. They were so fearful that the Moabites did not dare to attack Israel

THE REQUEST BY THE KING OF MOAB TO CURSE THE PEOPLE OF ISRAEL NUMBERS 22:4-8

- 1. King Balak's request to Balaam to curse the people of Israel
 - a. He sent his messengers all the way to the River Euphrates... the land of the Mesopotamians
 - b. He sent the elders of Moab and Midian to Balaam
- 2. King Balak believed that through curses, he may defeat Israel
- 3. And he can drive them out of the land

THE LORD'S BLESSING OF PROTECTION ON ISRAEL NUMBERS 22:9-13

- 1. The Lord's special protection over the people of Israel
 - a. Curses cannot affect those who belong to the Lord
 - b. Those who have faith in the Lord would be protected by the Lord
 - c. The Lord's covenant to Abraham Genesis 12:1-3
 - d. The Lord God had hedged His people Psalms 139:5
- 2. The Lord instructed Balaam that he was not to go with the elders
- 3. There was the Lord's special blessing of protection upon the people of Israel
- 4. He refused to let Balaam pronounce a curse on His people

THE COMPROMISE OF BALAAM NUMBERS 22:14-21

- 1. Balak sent even more honourable princes to Balaam with a greater offer of reward
- 2. Balaam knew that he could not go beyond what the Lord had told him
- 3. Yet, because of the lure of money and great worldly honour, he was willing to compromise

PERSONAL APPLICATION

- 1. Trusting in the Lord's protection
 - a. There is the Lord's hand of protection
 - i. He hedges us
 - ii. He protects us in ways we don't even know
 - b. He blesses and protects us because He loves us Deuteronomy 23:5
- 2. Not compromising on our faith
 - a. We should never compromise on our faith for anything
 - b. We can end up compromising like Balaam
 - i. For the sake of money
 - ii. For worldly honour
 - c. Let's make sure that we will never compromise on our faith
