Example 1

b) Power to forgive sins	Mark 2:5

c) Power to heal Mark 2:11-12

a) Why does this Man speak blasphemies? Mark 2:7b) Who can forgive sins but God alone? Mark 2:7

Example 2

1. The Calling of Matthew 9:9

a) A tax collector

b) Invitation extended: "Follow Me" Matthew 9:9

c) Response of Matthew: "So he arose and followed Him" Matthew 9:9

2. The significance

a) Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick

Matthew 9:12

- c) I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners, to repentance Matthew 9:13
