- 3. They had trouble accepting this teaching

### RESPONSE AT THE SECOND TEACHING OF CHRIST'S SUFFERING

1.	Great sorrow felt	Matthew 17:23
2.	They did not fully understand what Jesus meant	Mark 9:32
3.	They were afraid to ask Him	Mark 9:32
4.	This was hidden from them	Luke 9:45

The above is a general description of the Disciples.

### THE LACK OF COMPREHENSION

- 1. Despite seeing Jesus transfigured
- 2. Despite assurance that Jesus would rise from the dead on the third day
- 3. A lack of faith
- 4. Unbelief had settled in more deeply than they had comprehended
- 5. Because of all of the above, understanding was hidden from them
