 - b) Prophets
 - c) Via dreams and visions

1. The world of Noah
 - a) Ungodly 2 Peter 2:5
 - b) Great wickedness Genesis 6:5

- c) Intents of the heart evil continually Genesis 6:5

1. Imputed righteousness
